I understand that the Trust is separate from, and administered separately from, the Alhambra Seventh-Day Adventist Church. I understand that any funds I obtain by means of this application are a *grant, not an entitlement*, and that in accordance with the Trust documents the Trustees have *sole discretion* to award, or not to award, educational grants, to determine whether any such grants will be awarded in any given year, to determine criteria for any such grants and evaluate any application for such grants, and discretion to determine the number and size of any such grants. I understand that the Trustees have discretion to award no educational grants, and to use or not use Trust assets for other purposes as outlined in the Trust documents, as determined to be proper in the sole judgment of the Trustees in their management of the Trust. Applications for educational funds need to be made annually, for the academic year in which such funds will be used. Funds may be paid to the school, in the Trustees' discretion, as a tuition grant, rather than being paid directly to the student.
