Discussion Questions:

- 1. Many believers in Corinth manifested a desire to gain cultural approval. Why is that so dangerous to Christian identity? What can we do to prevent ourselves from making the same mistake?**
- 2. Paul's rhetorical question "Do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit?" (1 Cor. 6:19, NKJV) closes a series of seven questions in 1 Corinthians 5-6 introduced by the formula "Do you not know?" (1 Cor. 5:6; 1 Cor. 6:2-3, 9, 15, 16, 19). All of them demand an affirmative and emphatic answer-- something like "Of course you do." How do these questions help us understand Paul's concerns about the church? Why should we, too, be concerned about these issues today?**
- 3. Marriage is from God (Gen. 1:27-28; Gen. 2:18-24) and must be honored (Heb. 13:4). In a time when many consider it old-fashioned, how can we show the world that marriage is really a gift from God, directly from Eden itself?**
