

# Small Group Discussion Guide

“Gratitude Gone Viral” • Pastor Mel Baga, D.Min. • Nov 27, 2025

## OPEN

Describe a time when someone’s kindness toward you inspired you to pass kindness on to someone else.

## READ

Read 2 Corinthians 9:10-12, pray, pause for a few moments. Listen for the movement of the text. Then discuss.

## DISCUSS

1. According to Paul, where does generosity start? (See v. 10—“the One who supplies seed...”)
2. Paul says we are “enriched in every way” so that we can be generous. How have you seen God’s blessings pass *through* someone instead of just to someone?
3. Verse 12 says our generosity “overflows in many thanksgivings to God.” Where have you seen gratitude “go viral”—one act leading to many praises? How does this passage reshape your view of giving? What would it be like for your generosity to spark thanksgiving in someone else?

## LIVE IT OUT

This week, choose one small act of generosity and ask God to use it to multiply thanksgiving—then come ready next time to share what happened.

## **PRAY**

There's power when we pray out loud together. Speaking our prayers engages our hearts, and praying as a group reminds us we're not alone. As we say this prayer in one voice, may gratitude and faith rise in us.

Let's say this prayer out loud together:

Lord,

You are the One who supplies every seed  
and multiplies every good thing.

Make us channels of Your generosity.

Let our giving meet real needs,  
lift discouraged hearts,  
and overflow into many thanksgivings  
to You.

Use our small acts to spread Your grace  
farther than we imagine.

Make gratitude go viral through us.

In Jesus' name, Amen.
