

# 2026 Summer STEAM

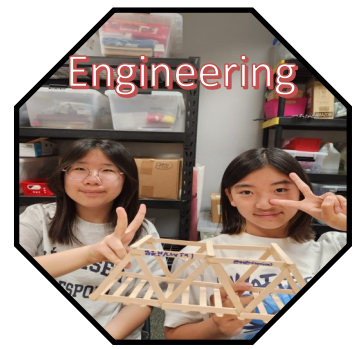
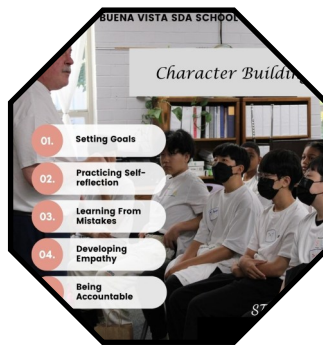
