Dr. Abraham Jules

Abraham J. Jules has served as a Pastor in the New York City area for the last forty -two years. He is a much sought after speaker who has preached across North America, Africa, Europe, the West Indies, and the South Pacific. His passion for evangelism is palpable, and his giftedness in that area is widely acclaimed.

A pastor of uncommon charisma and leadership ability, Jules is adept and adroit at growing churches spiritually and numerically, leading from the pulpit with a brand of preaching that is intense, energetic, and uncompromising; he is also known for his keen facilitation skills in the boardroom.

He was born in Trinidad, W.I. and is a graduate of Oakwood University (BA), the Seventh -day Adventist Theological Seminary (Masters of Divinity), and United Theological Seminary in Dayton, Ohio (Doctor of Ministry). He has been a guest presenter to fellow ministers on numerous occasions, ministering the word for the purpose of professional growth. He lectures occasionally at Andrews University on preaching and leadership.

Dr. Jules served as the President of the Northeastern Conference up until June 6, 2024, when he was elected President of the Atlantic Union Conference. He is married to Dr. Dominique Jules, formerly Juste, and is the father of two children, Raven, a first year law student at Howard University, and Dylan, a sophomore at Oakwood University.

Pastor Roger Hernandez

Roger Hernandez is a father of four, a husband of one, and a pastor to many. Presently he is the Ministerial and Evangelism Director for the Southern Union Conference of Seventh-day Adventists. He has served in the ministry for over 30 years.

One of seven pastors in his family, Pr. Hernandez received his BS degree in Theology as a graduate of Columbia Union College, now Washington Adventist University. He received his MDiv. from Andrews University Adventist Seminary.

Born in Cuba and fully bilingual, Pastor Hernandez has participated in events in both English and Spanish. Roger is a speaker that motivates people to action and has spoken all over the world effectively in both the faith-based and business spaces. He speaks on leadership, evangelism, accountability, and diversity (LEAD). He connects well with all audiences of all generations and is known for delivering messages in a clear, simple, and engaging style. He has the gift of practicality.

Pr. Hernandez's hobbies are reading, writing, traveling, and playing a variety of sports. His love for Jordan's is well known. Some of his passions are mentoring, public speaking, church planting and helping in the revitalization process of congregations.

Roger is a prolific writer and the author of over 34 books in a variety of topics like relationships, parenting, evangelism, church growth as well as preaching, including the Sharing book of the year twice. They are titled "Failure is Not Final" and "We All Have Problems." He also had the privilege of writing the Discipleship Book of the Year: "Everyone Welcome." The most recent book he has written is "Graceful Parenting" published in 2025.

Roger's family includes his wife, Kathy, four adult children Yessenia, Deisy, Vanessa, Jonathan, and 4 granddaughters, Sara, Maya, Aida and Ismari.





Calvin B. Rock, DMin, PhD

Calvin B. Rock's life is a testament to faith, perseverance, and visionary leadership. A native of New York City, his early years were shaped by experiences in both New York and Philadelphia before his family relocated to Los Angeles, California, at the age of eleven. These formative influences helped cultivate the discipline, spiritual grounding, and sense of purpose that would guide his life's work.

Dr. Rock is a product of Christian education through Oakwood College—an institution that would later become central to his legacy. He pursued graduate studies at the University of Detroit, where he earned a Master of Arts degree in Sociology, and continued his academic

preparation at Michigan State University and St. John's University. He later earned both the Doctor of Ministry and Doctor of Philosophy degrees in Religious Ethics from Vanderbilt University. In January 1952, Dr. Rock began what would become more than sixty years of active ministry. His pastoral journey began in the South Atlantic Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, where he pastored congregations in Augusta, Georgia; Columbia, Johnston, and Sumter, South Carolina. He later pastored churches in Winter Park, Orlando, Sanford, and Apopka, Florida; and in Fort Lauderdale, Dania, Miami, Homestead, and Key West, Florida. He also pastored congregations in Detroit, Michigan, and New York City. Even after formal retirement, his pastoral commitment continued in Las Vegas, Nevada, and Phoenix, Arizona.

In April 1971, he was elected the eighth president of Oakwood College in Huntsville, Alabama. During his fourteen-year tenure, enrollment grew significantly—from 572 to 1,400 students—reflecting both institutional growth and a strengthened mission. In July 1985, Dr. Rock was elected as one of six Vice Presidents of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventists. In this capacity, he chaired the boards of Loma Linda University and its affiliated hospital for eleven years, and the Oakwood College Board for six years. He is the founder of Operation ReachBack, Inc., and served as Chairman of the Board from its inception in 1994 until his retirement from that role on December 31, 2025—an enduring commitment to community uplift and service. A gifted communicator and devoted evangelist, Dr. Rock has conducted soul-winning campaigns throughout the United States and internationally in England, Ghana, Kenya, Zimbabwe, Russia, and Romania. His ministry has taken him to seventy-two countries, reflecting a truly global influence. He is the author of eight books, most published by Seventh-day Adventist publishing houses in North America. His most recent work, *Protest and Progress*, is widely regarded as a significant and enduring contribution to the history of Black Seventh-day Adventists.

At the heart of Dr. Rock's life is family. He is the father of three daughters—Cheryl, Celia, and Connie—and a proud grandfather and great-grandfather. Following the passing of his beloved wife of sixty-five years, the late Clara Peterson Rock, he was blessed to find companionship again and is now married to his wife, the former Sharon Kay Kelly.

Among his most cherished honors are the Doctor of Divinity degree from Andrews University, a Doctor of Philosophy degree from University of Eastern Africa, Baraton, the Distinguished Leadership Award from the United Negro College Fund, the Living Legends Award for Service to Humanity, and the President's Lifetime Achievement Award, conferred by Joseph R. Biden Jr.

Dr. Rock's favorite Bible author is the Apostle Paul and his favorite Scriptural study is Righteousness by Faith.



Pastor Debleaire Snell

Pastor Debleaire K. Snell was born in Tallahassee, Florida to Deborah and Larry Snell. In 1999, he graduated with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Theology from Oakwood University. In Spring of 1999, he accepted a call to pastor with the South Central Seventh-day Adventist Conference in Nashville, TN.

Upon graduating, Pastor Snell began his graduate school matriculation at Andrews University. While at Andrews, he served as the Youth Pastor for the Praise Fellowship SDA Church in South Bend, Indiana. In December of 2001, he received his Masters of Divinity from Andrews Theological Seminary.

From 2002-2006 Pastor Snell led a two Church district in Columbus and West Point, MS. From 2006-2010 he served as the lead pastor of the Lima Drive SDA Church in Lexington, KY. On July 17th 2010 Pastor Snell began his post as the Senior Pastor of the First SDA Church of Huntsville, AL. Since his arrival at First Church, explosive growth has taken place as hundreds of souls have been baptized in the last 10 years.

Pastor Snell also serves as an adjunct professor for the religion department at Oakwood University. Pastor Snell is also the author of six books, including, *Almost Home*, *New Normals*, *Leap Year*, and *Making Christianity Great Again*. He has had numerous articles and essays published. His favorite text is II Corinthians 5:17, which states “*Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.*”

On July 28, 2021, the North American Division Adventist Media Ministries board voted to accept the name of Debleaire Snell as the new Speaker/Director for Breath of Life Television Ministries.

Pastor Snell currently also serves as the new Senior Pastor of Oakwood University Church.

Pastor Kimberly Mann

PASTOR KIMBERLY MANN originally hails from the state of Maryland and is the only daughter of Elaine Pearson. Her calling to share the gospel has been evident since her early years, when she preached her first sermon at age 9 and began being published at 10 years old. She is a proud product of Pine Forge Academy & received a Bachelor's in Education from Oakwood University in 2005.



Kimberly served as an educator with the Florida Conference of Seventh-day Adventists for 5 years until she was called to ministry full-time.

In 2012, she graduated with a Master's Degree in Youth & Young Adult Ministry from Andrew's Theological Seminary and then spent the next 7 years doing young adult ministry, organizing the freshman worship experience, branding a young women's leadership program, Legacy 31, and completing over 12 national and international mission trips while serving as Associate Chaplain at Oakwood University.

In addition to preaching and teaching, she can be seen as a panelist and co-host on the television show, Pure Choices, on the Dare 2 Dream Network. Kimberly has spent over 15 years advocating for justice within underserved communities and youth in the non-profit sector through the Children's Defense Fund under the famed Civil Rights Activist Dr. Marian Wright Edelman, where she was named as one of the Top 40 under 40 leaders in America by the Organization.

Additionally, Kimberly was recognized by Pine Forge Academy as Alumni of the Year for community service in 2017. She is a Commissioned Minister and has been endorsed as a Chaplain by the North American Division. From 2019-2022, Kimberly served as the very first female Youth Director of the South Central Conference, helping to successfully lead the department during a global pandemic. She also served on the BAYDA committee, where she founded the P.U.S.H. Initiative, a Social Justice Action model for youth and young adults. Her combined 17 years of ministry experience include creative arts ministries, children's ministries, women's ministry, youth and young adult ministry, and marriage/relationship ministry. She has preached to congregations and communities all across the U.S., Caribbean, Africa, Australia, and Brazil.

Pastor Mann and her supportive husband, Robert Mann, Jr, are the proud parents of Carter, Judah, and baby Teagan. Kimberly's greatest joy is authentically embracing the unique calling to share the gospel as a wife, mother, minister, and history maker.

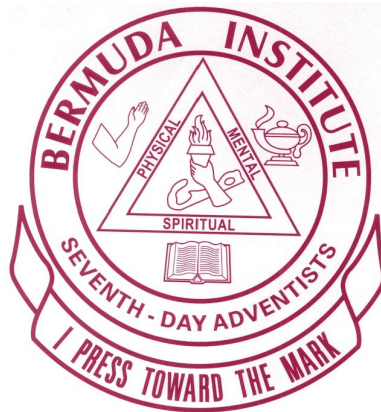

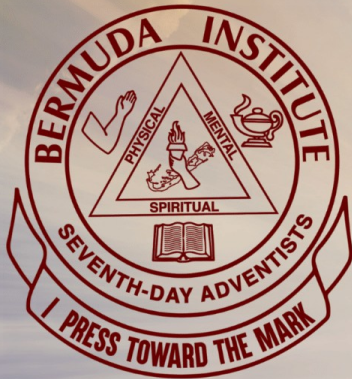
