WEEKLY FASTING FRAMEWORK (CHURCH-WIDE)



Daily Media Fast (Sunday-Sabbath)

Abstain from:

- Social media
- Streaming & entertainment
- News & unnecessary screen time

Replace with:

- Scripture reading
- Prayer
- Silence before God
- Journaling

Wednesday Food Fast

- Fast from food on **Wednesday** (sunrise to sunset or as health allows)
- Water permitted; adjust for medical needs
- Purpose: humility, surrender, and renewed hunger for God

DAILY GUIDE

SUNDAY – AWAKENED BY HIS LOVE

Theme: Revival begins when love awakens hunger for Christ

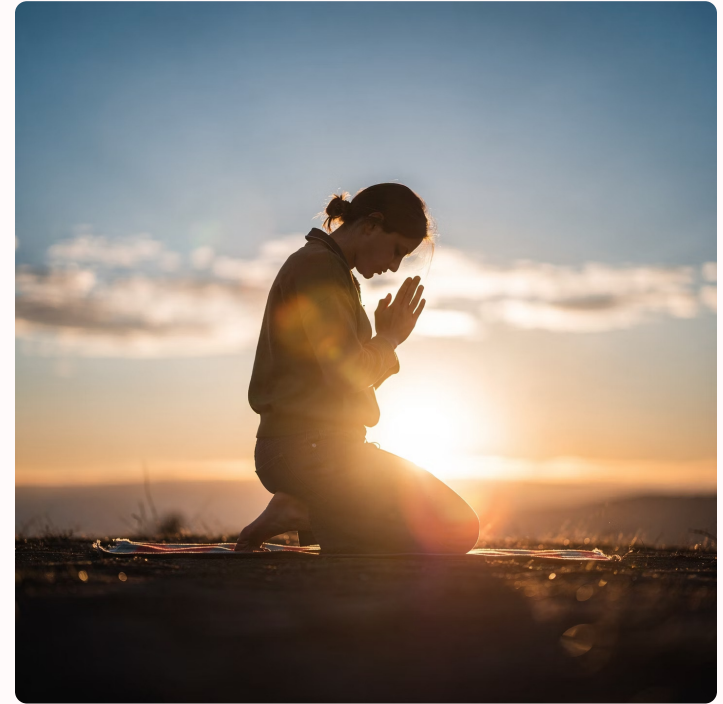
Scripture Focus: Philippians 3:10; Revelation 2:4–5

Reflection: Personal revival begins when God gently reveals where affection has cooled. His love does not shame us—it **calls us back**. Awakening starts when we respond to His invitation.

Prayer Focus:

- Ask God to awaken your heart
- Repent of spiritual complacency
- Receive His restoring love

Action Step: Spend **15 minutes in silence** before God—no media, no agenda, just presence.



MONDAY – KNOWING HIM, NOT JUST ABOUT HIM

Theme: Revival is relational, not informational

Scripture Focus: Philippians 3:10a; Jeremiah 9:23–24

Reflection

Paul's desire was intimacy, not activity. God's love invites us into daily fellowship, moving from knowledge **about** Him to knowing Him deeply.

Prayer Focus

- Ask for deeper intimacy with Christ
- Surrender distractions and busyness
- Welcome the Holy Spirit into everyday moments

Action Step

Read Scripture slowly today. Pause and ask, "What does this reveal about God's heart?"

TUESDAY — TRANSFORMED BY RESURRECTION POWER

Theme: [God's love releases resurrection life](#)

Scripture Focus: Philippians 3:10b; Romans 8:11



Reflection: Resurrection power is not only future—it revives weary faith now. God's love breathes life into places that feel dormant or discouraged.

Prayer Focus:

- Invite resurrection life into stagnant areas
- Pray for renewed joy and passion
- Declare life over weariness

☐ **Action Step:** Name one "dead" area in your spiritual life and pray resurrection over it.

WEDNESDAY – SURRENDERED THROUGH LOVE

Theme: Love empowers full surrender

Scripture Focus: Philippians 3:10c; Romans 12:1



Fasting Focus

- **Fast from food today**
- Let physical hunger sharpen spiritual dependence



Reflection

Participation in Christ's sufferings is about surrender, not suffering for its own sake. Love strengthens us to lay down control and trust God completely.

Prayer Focus:

- Offer your life anew to God
- Release fear, pride, and self-reliance
- Ask for grace to obey fully

Action Step: During usual mealtimes, pray: "Lord, I desire You more than comfort."

THURSDAY – FORMED INTO CHRIST'S LIKENESS

Theme: God's love transforms character

Scripture Focus: Philippians 3:10d; 2 Corinthians 3:18

Reflection: Revival is measured by transformation. As we remain in God's loving presence, He reshapes our attitudes, words, and responses to reflect Christ.



Prayer Focus:

- Invite God's refining work
- Receive conviction without condemnation
- Ask to love others as Christ loves you

Action Step: Intentionally show Christlike love to one person today.

FRIDAY – LIVING IN RESURRECTION HOPE

Theme: Revival restores eternal perspective

Scripture Focus: Philippians 3:11; Colossians 3:1–4

Reflection

When eternity becomes real, our priorities shift. God's love lifts our vision beyond temporary struggles and anchors us in lasting hope.

Prayer Focus

- Renew hope in Christ
- Release fear of loss or death
- Align your heart with God's kingdom purposes

Action Step

Journal: *"If I truly lived for eternity, what would change?"*



SABBATH (SATURDAY) – REVIVED TO LOVE AND SEND

Theme: Personal revival overflows into mission

Scripture Focus: Philippians 3:10–11; Matthew 22:37–39

Reflection: Revival culminates in love expressed outwardly. God fills us so we can carry Christ's love into families, workplaces, and communities.



Prayer Focus

- Thank God for renewal
- Ask for boldness and compassion
- Pray for the church to steward revival well



Action Step

Share a testimony or insight from Week 2 with someone.



Sabbath Gathering Emphasis

Worship, prayer, testimonies, and commissioning.

CLOSING ENCOURAGEMENT

Revival is sustained not by intensity, but by abiding in God's love.
