Pastor’s Corner:

Paul’s invitation, “Be imitators of me, as I am of Christ,” reminds us that the Christian life is about following Jesus. First, Christ is our model, and His defining characteristic is love (1 Corinthians 13). Spiritual gifts, knowledge, and religious activity are meaningless if they are not expressed through Christlike love.

Second, Peter’s story shows that love is proven not by bold promises but by faithful living. Though Peter confidently declared he would die for Jesus, he denied Him under pressure. After the resurrection, Jesus restored Peter and revealed that true love for Him is demonstrated by caring for others: “Feed My sheep.” Our love for Christ is seen in how we treat the people He loves.

Third, Christ calls us to make His love visible every day. Love is patient, kind, humble, truthful, forgiving, and enduring. It is shown in ordinary acts of service, compassion, and faithfulness, not merely in emotional moments or dramatic sacrifices.

The challenge of this message is simple: Do our lives reflect the love of Christ? As we follow Jesus, may His love shape our relationships so that others see Him through the way we live, serve, and love.
