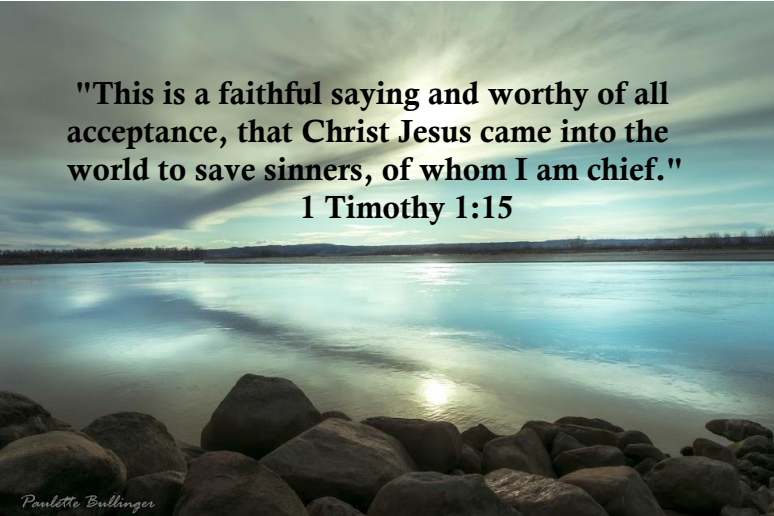


1. Online giving, scan the QR code and explore the Adventist online giving site. It’s a quick, easy and fun way to give.
