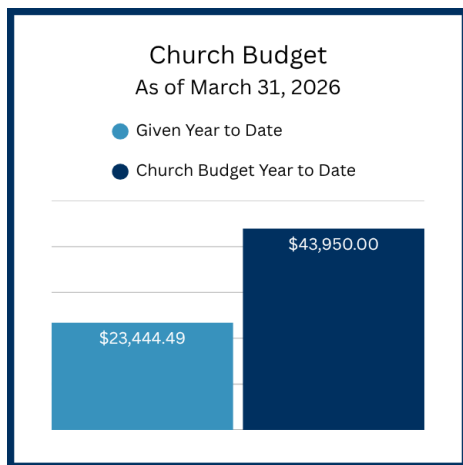


Offering Spotlight: Local Church Budget
