Tithe Envelope Explained



This image depicts a tithe and offering envelope used by the Northeastern Conference to collect monetary donations from its members. The envelope provides spaces for the donor to record their personal information (date, ID, name, address, church, phone) and to allocate their contributions to various funds. These funds are divided into "Conference Trust Funds" (including tithe, Sabbath School missions, and other specific causes) and "Local Church Offerings" (such as the combined budget and building fund). The envelope also includes a section to record the total amount enclosed and a section for office use to verify the form of payment (cash or check) and the amount received.
