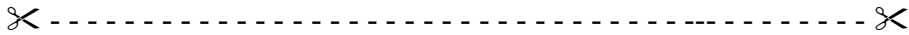

HEALTH NUGGET: Wash your potatoes thoroughly and leave the skin on for an extra fibre boost. The skin provides insoluble fibre, which keeps us regular and plays an important role in carrying food through our digestive system. Cooking and cooling potatoes increases their resistant starch content. This is another type of fibre, and acts as a prebiotic, feeding the good bacteria in your gut.
