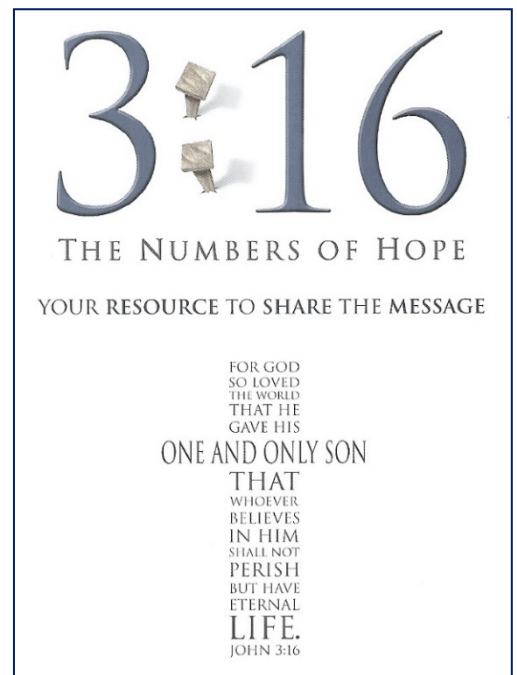

John 14:27(NLT)

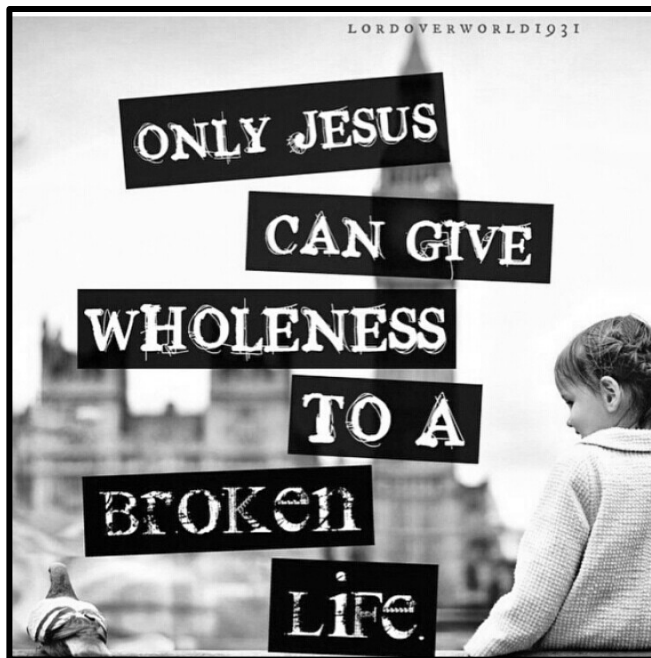
4. Enjoy Personal _____ with God
