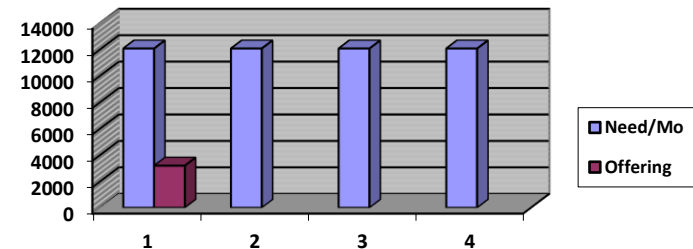

Church Volunteer Policy

Any SECC local church that will use volunteers in any capacity is required to follow this Church Volunteer Policy. There are two types of volunteers, volunteer 1 and volunteer 2 - volunteer level 2 requires additional requirements since they work frequently and closely with children. All volunteers must sign an acknowledgement form.

Volunteers level 1&2 must Sign and submit [SECC Volunteer Acknowledgement Form](#). Form is attached or can be accessed at link below.

What to complete:

- (volunteer level 1) Training in Mandatory Reporting
- (volunteer level 2) Live Scan Fingerprinted Background Check
- Any volunteer with driving as part of their duties, a DMV check/clearance is required

Child Abuse & Neglect Identification & Mandated Reporting

- **Where To Get the Training**
 - <https://mandatedreporter.ca.com>
 - upload the certificate of completion to VOLUNTEERS
- Must be done **every two (2) years**

Volunteer Level 2

- Complete the **“Request for Live Scan Service” Form**
- **Once Request for Livescan Service form is completed, Google location of “Livescan” business closest to where you live, go get your fingerprinting process done.**
- **Pay for Livescan, obtain receipt and submit to church for Reimbursement**
- **Livescan is done only one time for volunteer level 2**
