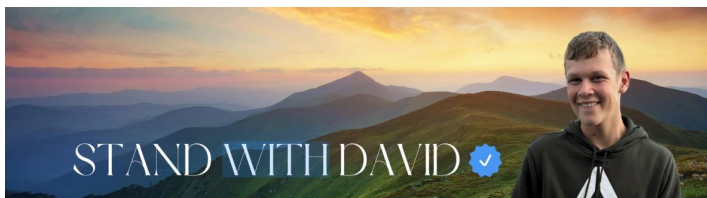

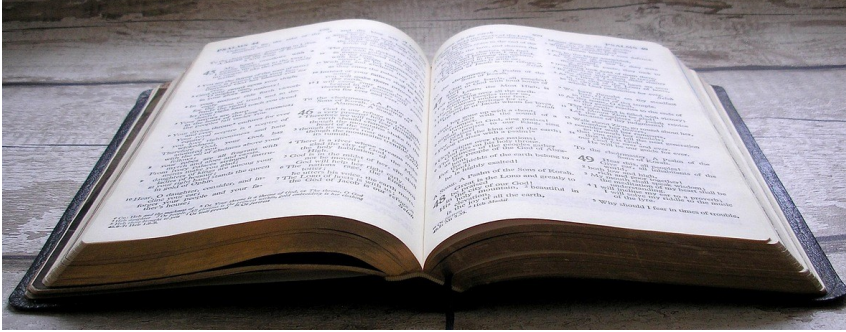
GROWING STRONGER SEMINAR *Mondays, Jan. 12 – Mar. 9, SonBridge Center for Better Living*

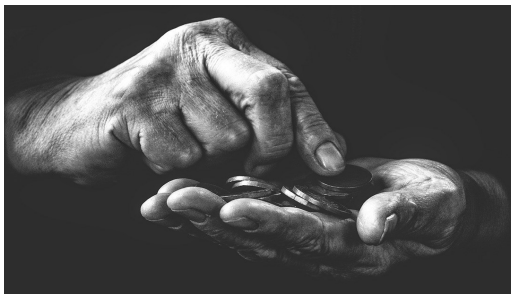
