LEST WE FORGT

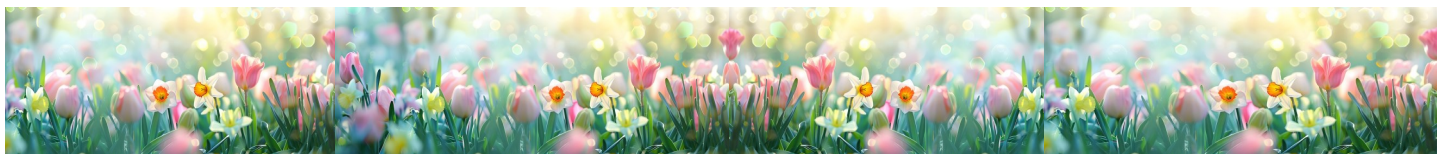
