BACKGROUND CHECKS

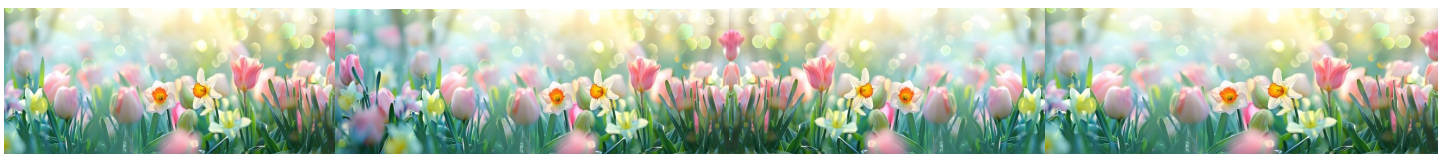



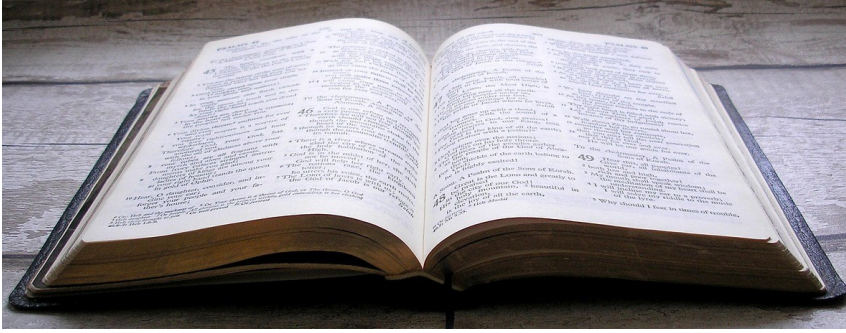
