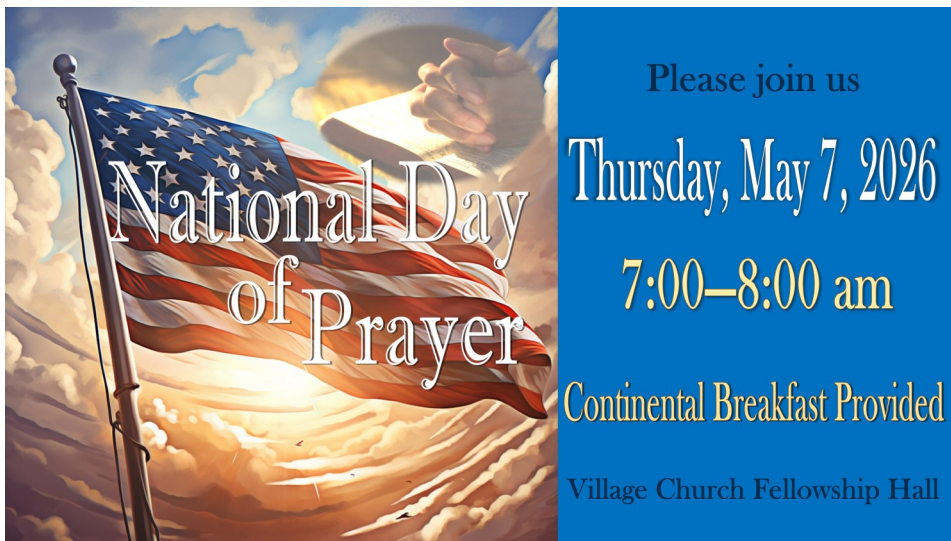

NAVIGATING ACTIVE THREATS—APRIL 20, 7:00 PM

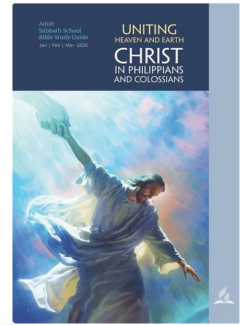

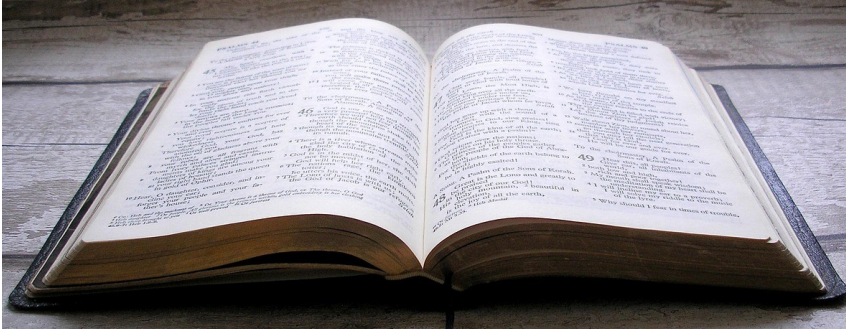
