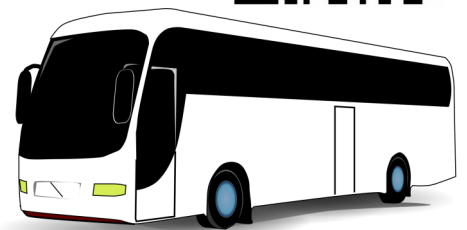
#### IT TAKES A VILLAGE

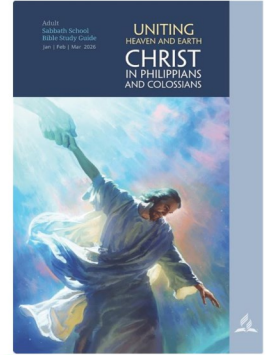

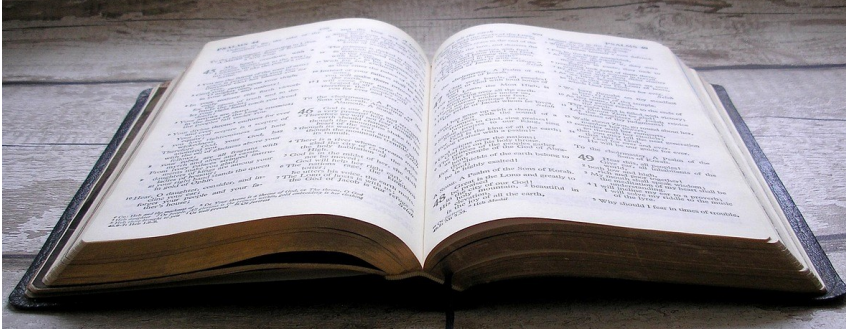
