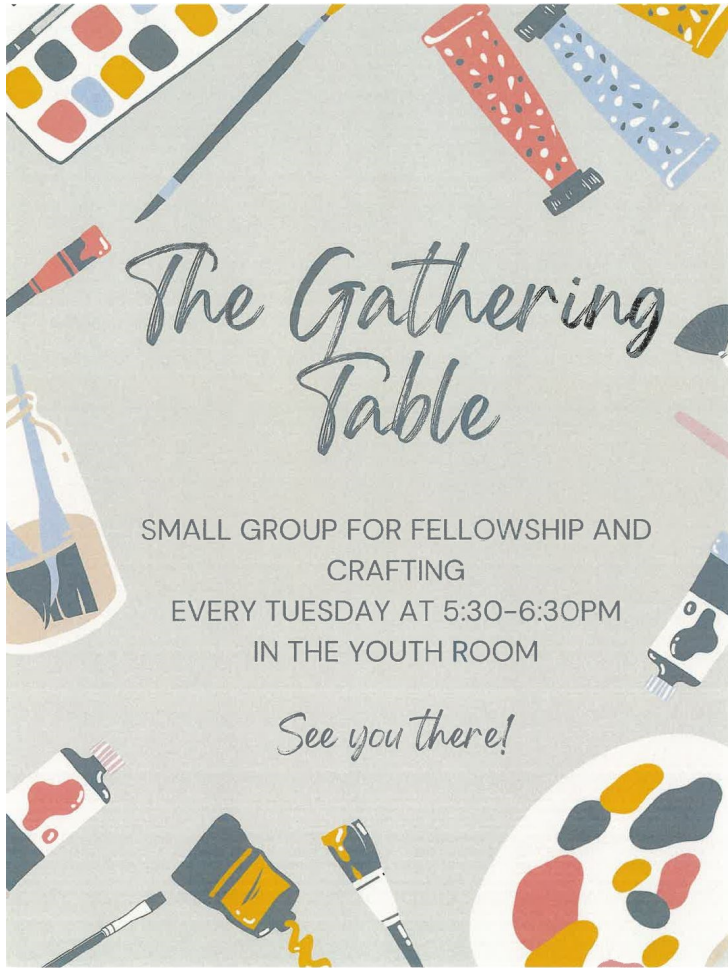

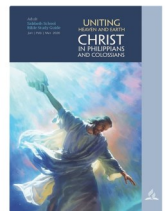


### FRIENDLY REMINDER

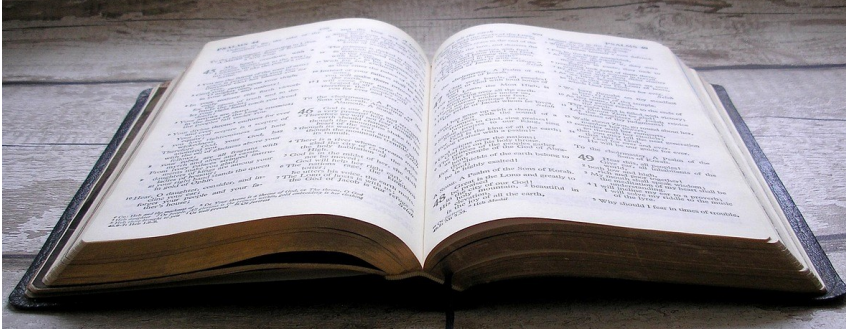
