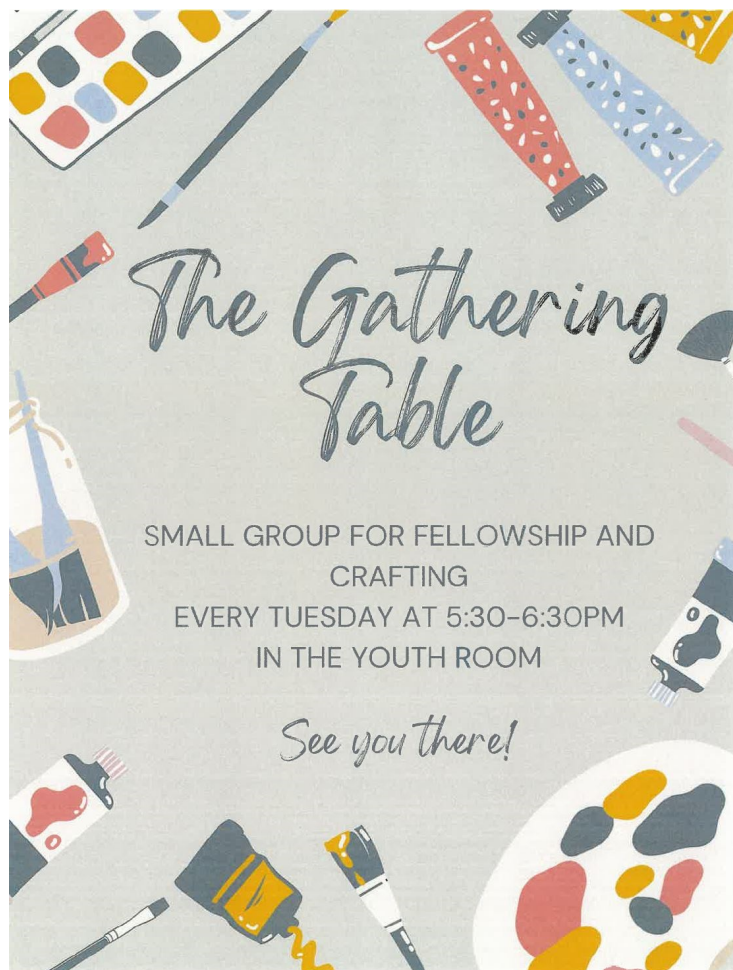

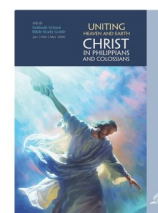


FRIENDLY REMINDER

REACHING BUDDHISTS

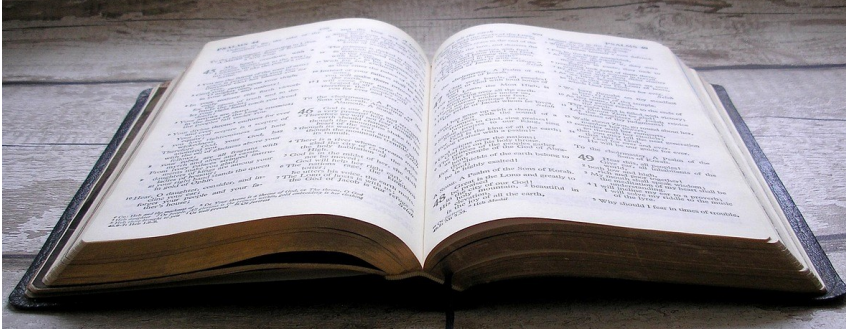

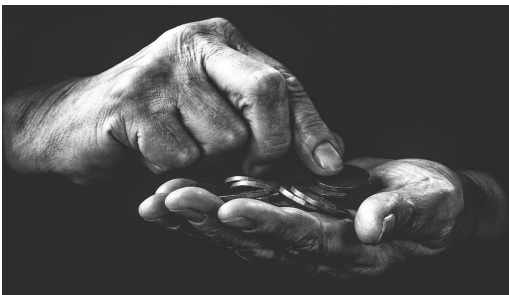
