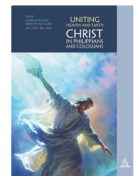

### THE APPROACHING STORM: A VIDEO SERIES FROM VOICE OF PROPHECY

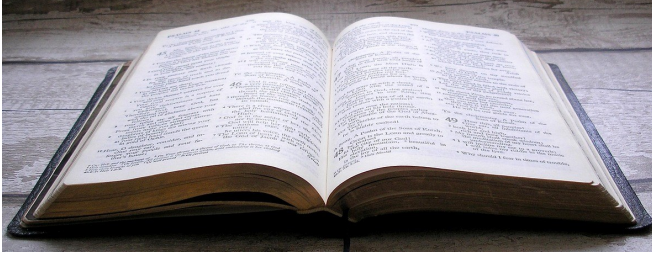

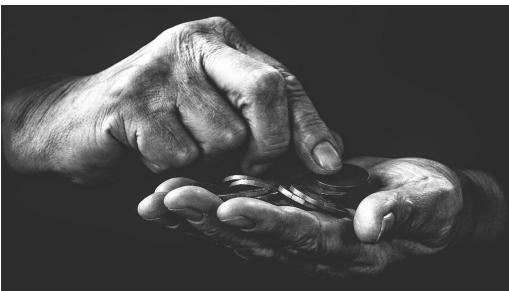
