GOSPEL OUTREACH IS SEEKING REGIONAL DIRECTORS

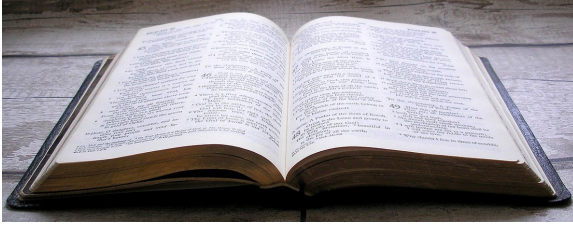

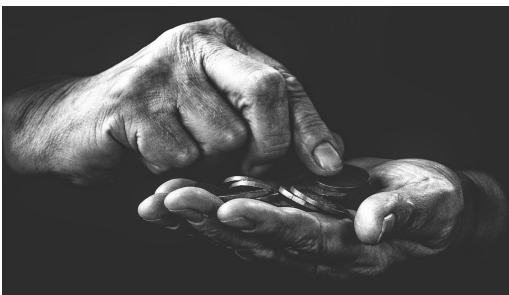
