NPUC CONSTITUENCY SESSION 2026

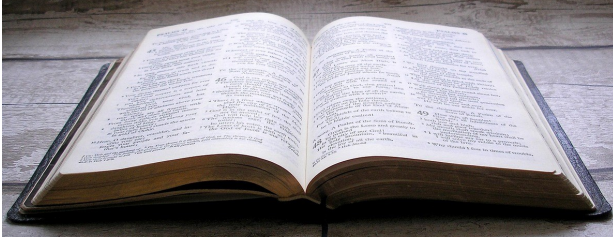
