NEW RESEARCH: THE BIG QUESTIONS ON TEENS' MINDS

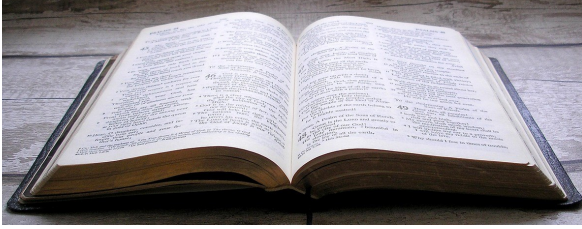
