Tim Roosenberg will present part one of his three-part seminar in the sanctuary during the adult lesson study time. All are welcome to stay for his presentation.



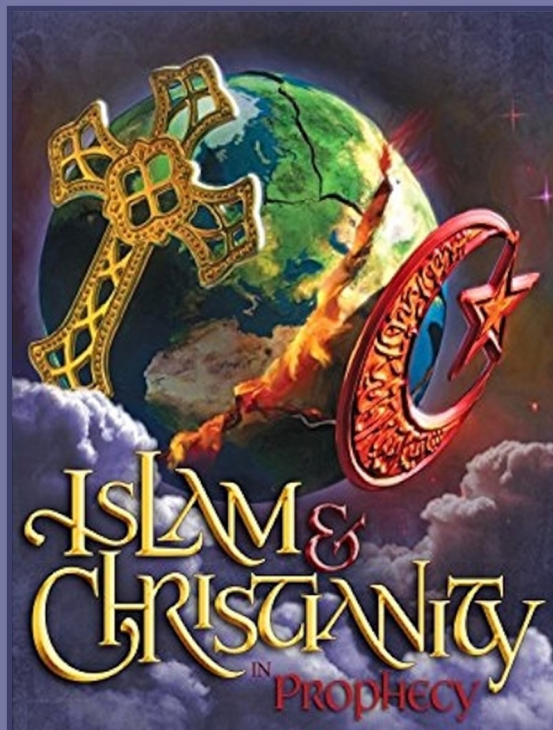

15TH ANNUAL BOB LARRABEE CHARITY GOLF TOURNAMENT (SPOKANE, WA) — SEPTEMBER 25

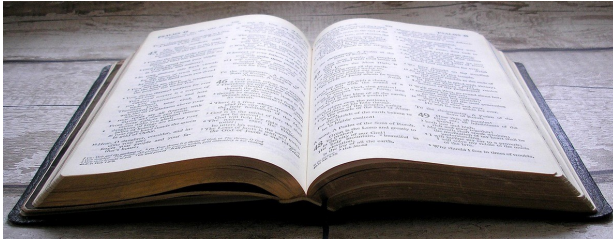
