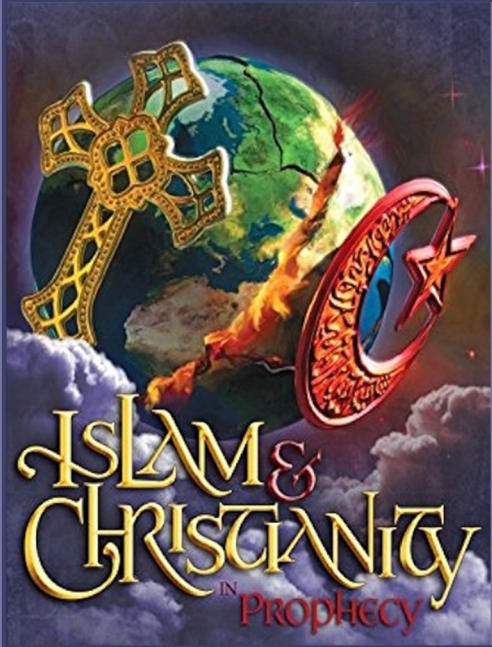

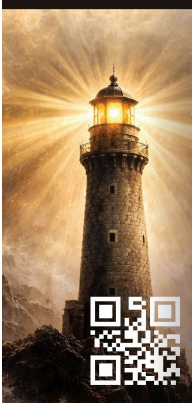

In 2005, he was invited to serve as president of the Georgia-Cumberland Conference, where he served for 14 ½ years until his retirement in 2019.

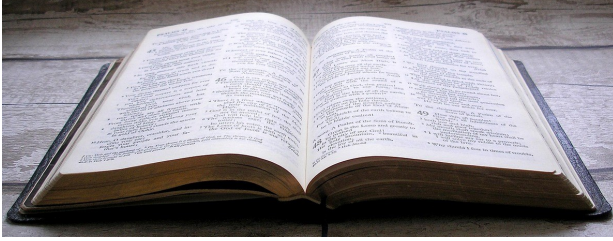

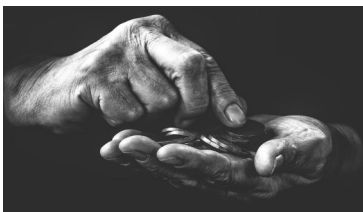
