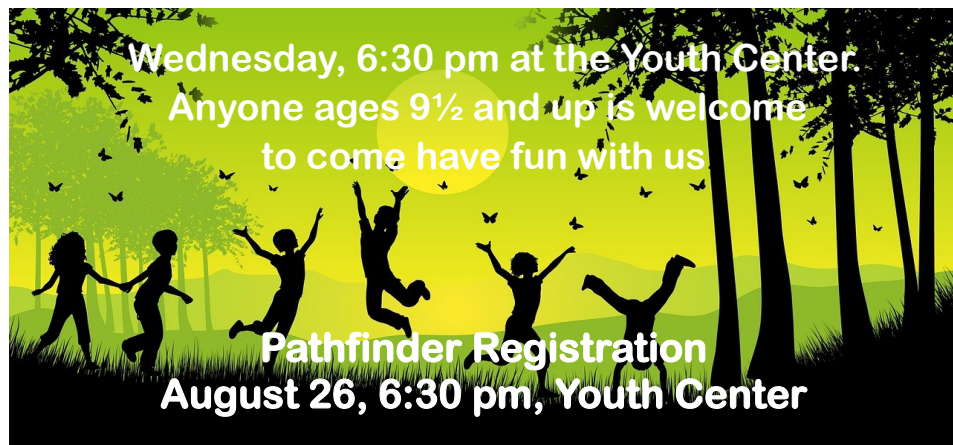


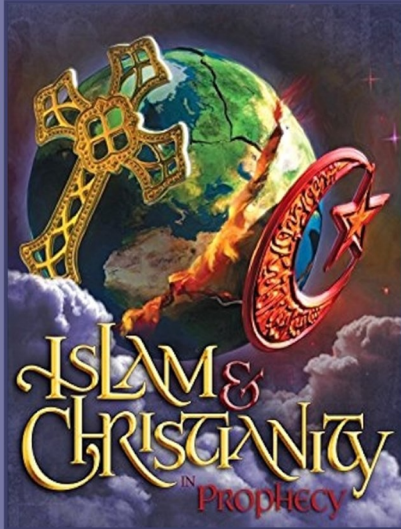

MARANATHA VOLUNTEERS PREPARE CAMP MIVODEN FOR SUMMER MINISTRY

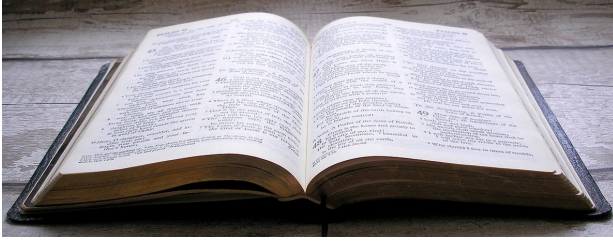

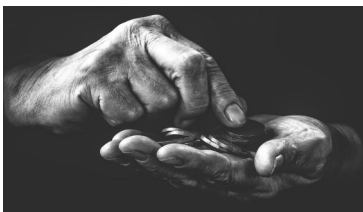
