ADVENTIST UNIVERSITIES AND HOPE STUDIOS COLLABORATE TO CREATE 'IMAGINE FAITH'

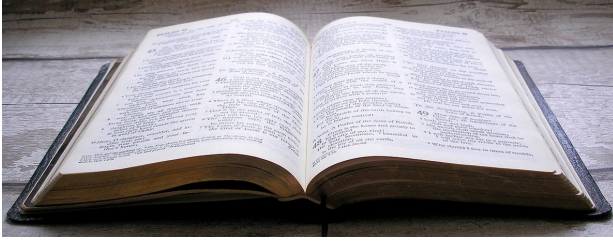
