ADVENTIST HERITAGE SABBATH, OCTOBER 24

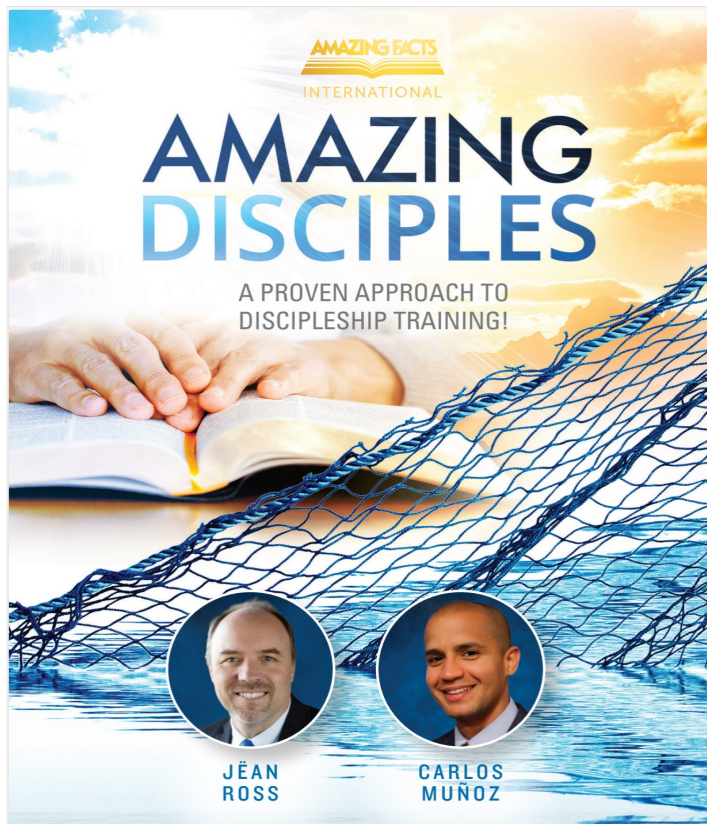

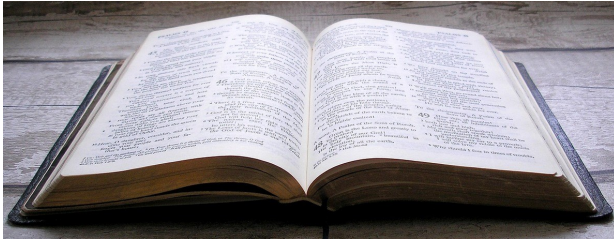

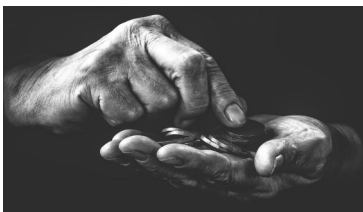
