A Legacy of Faith & Love

Barbara Ann Davis Trumbore, of Stockbridge, GA surrounded by love passed away peacefully at 10:44 Wednesday evening March 11, 2026, at Piedmont Henry Hospital ICU.

She was born March 3, 1952, the sixth child and fourth girl of eight children born to the Late Dennie C. and Mary B. Davis of Blakely Early County GA. She is survived by four of her siblings who are present today: Willie C. (Jean), Walter (Annette), Dennie, Jr (Pamela), Jo (Nathaniel).

Barbara's formal education started in 1958 at the consolidated Washington Elementary and High School at age six. While in high school, she was a class leader, school queen, and honor graduate of the Class of 1970, the last class of the historic Black American Washington High School. After high school she earned an Associate Degree from Andrews College; Cuthbert, GA, a Bachelor's Degree, and Educational Specialist Degree from Troy University; Troy, Alabama.

She taught in public and parochial schools in Telford, Pennsylvania, Albany and Atlanta Georgia areas. In 1997, it was Barbara, who God led to open the Decatur Adventist Junior Academy and the Conyers Adventist Christian Academy in 2018 at both institutions as the first principal. During her career she was honored as a Who's Who recipient among America's outstanding educators. She enjoyed writing the Kid's Corner for a local newspaper for many years. At retirement, from Clayton County Public Schools as a teacher of gifted students, she had invested more than 35 years of service. Barbara was the honoree chosen by Conyers Adventist Christian Academy on September 2023 on the occasion of its 5th Anniversary Celebration.

As a teacher sent by God, Barbara's passion and greatest joy was the blessing of having taught hundreds of students. She praised God for their successes in unimaginable occupations, and was an inspiration to her colleagues. Most importantly, she will be looking for all of them in heaven and to inherit the Earth Made-New (Revelation 21) - her ultimate goal in life!

Barbara was raised to love God exercising her faith in worship and service in Blakely, Georgia at the Hayes Grove Baptist Church and the Mount Olive Baptist Church. Later, God led her to Newark, New Jersey where she lived with her older sister, Freddie and her family. It was in New Jersey that Barbara was introduced to the Seventh-day Adventist way of worship and lifestyle. Many are with us today because of her witness. Her faith in God was like fire shut up in her bones - "just couldn't keep it to herself" - a quiet storm!

Barbara and her late husband, Jeff were foster parents and later, gained a bonus daughter, Hayleigh. Deidral "Dede" is oldest of her two daughters. Dede blessed the family circle with three precious children: Tyler, Brianna Renay, and Kayla Kristina. These three grands blessed Dede (Mark) with four amazing gifts: Cori, Quon, Kailea, and Aayan making Barbara a great grandmother - a growing legacy of faith and love continuing!
