Potluck Glow-Up Survey Data Analysis and Action Plan

Total Responses Received: 59

1. Participation & Structure (Questions 1–3)

- Past Experience (Q1):
 - 78% have served on/hosted/organized a potluck team before
 - 22% have not served on/hosted/organized a potluck team before
- Preferred Format (Q2):
 - Structured Teams: 51%
 - All-Church/Less Structured: 49%
- Desired Frequency (Q3):
 - Bi-Weekly (24 per year): 53%
 - Weekly (52 per year): 27%
 - Monthly (12 per year): 20%

Action Item: To reduce burnout, we need 6-8 teams to host 24 potlucks a year.

2. Dietary Accommodations (Questions 4–5)

- Vegetarian Status (Q4):
 - 20 individuals/households require vegetarian options
- Top 3 Health/Allergy Concerns (Q5):
 - 22 respondents/households have health-related food restrictions
 1. Wheat/Gluten-Free (10 responses)
 2. TIE: Diabetic-Friendly/Low-Sugar ALSO Crustacean Shellfish (7 responses)
 3. Milk/Dairy-Free (6 responses)

Action Item: For the safety of our church family, we must label ALL dishes for potluck.

3. Logistics & Volunteer Pool (Questions 6–8)

- Winning Location (Q6):
 - Fellowship Hall with 81% of the vote
- Team Leaders Stepping Up (Q7):
 - 1 (new) person answered yes to leading a team
- Roster of Volunteers (Q8):
 - Bobbi Sands

Action Item: Reach out to volunteers to form teams and schedule rotation.

Over the past few years, I have been encouraged by the growing relationships between our churches throughout New Mexico. While we often gather for camp meetings, conferences, and ministry events, I have been thinking about additional ways we can strengthen those relationships, especially among our youth, young adults, and families.

With that in mind, Advent Life Church would like to invite your church to participate in what we hope will become an annual tradition: **Adventist Olympics**.

The vision is simple. We want to create opportunities for our churches to worship together, build friendships, encourage one another, and enjoy healthy competition in a Christ-centered environment. Rather than gathering only around meetings and programs, this gives us a chance to connect through fellowship, teamwork, and fun.

Our hope is to host a different sport throughout the year, including soccer, volleyball, basketball, and kickball, allowing churches from around the state to participate and build lasting relationships with one another.

Our first event will be:

Indoor Soccer Tournament
Saturday, August 22, 2026
Sandia View Academy

The evening will begin with a bilingual Vespers service as we welcome both English- and Spanish-speaking church families together in worship. Following sunset, we will transition into the tournament.

Tournament Details:

- Team Registration: \$125 per team
- Maximum Roster: 8 players
- Format: 6 vs. 6 Indoor Soccer
- Each team must have at least 2 female players on the court at all times
- Unlimited substitutions
- Two 10-minute halves
- Two-minute halftime
- Running clock
- No slide tackling
- Single-elimination tournament format
- Ties will be decided by a 3-player penalty shootout, followed by sudden death if necessary

We recognize that some churches may not have enough players to form a complete team. If needed, churches are welcome to combine with another church so that everyone who wants to participate has the opportunity to do so.

This event will also help support Advent Life Church's California Mission Trip while providing a fun and meaningful opportunity for our churches to come together.
