- We need **newspapers** for a craft if you have any extra to share.



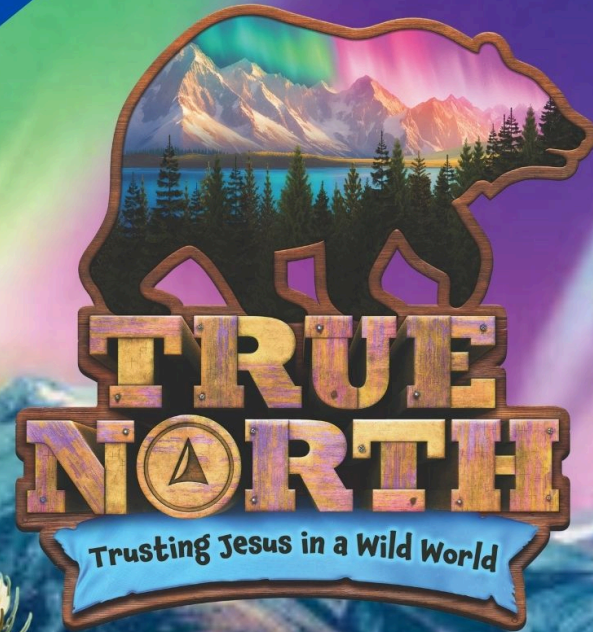

There is a **COLLECTION BIN** in the foyer for all VBS items.

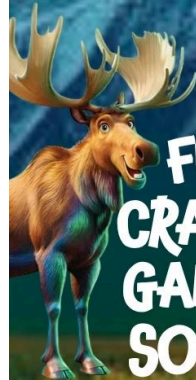
