

“Mama! Dada! Somebody! Help Me...”

1 Kings 3:16-21

Recap of Sermon on August 22, 2026

Elder Oneil Bryson gave a summary of the narrative in 1 Kings 3: 16-21. It is the story of two prostitutes who lived together and had recently given birth. During the night, one accidentally rolled over in the bed and, to use a social media euphemism, “unalived” the baby. She then switched the babies, placing her dead baby (her burden) on the chest of the other lady and placed the live baby on her breast. When the other mom woke up to nurse the baby, she noticed that the baby was dead. However, when she saw the baby in the morning light, she knew it was not her child. Don’t allow someone else to place their burden on you.

So the two women took the issue to King Solomon. The king sent for his sword and said to “
Cut the living child in two and give half to one and half to the other.”

The woman whose son was alive was deeply moved out of love for her son and said to the king, “Please, my lord, give her the living baby! Don’t kill him!” But the other said, “Neither I nor you shall have him. Cut him in two!” Then the king gave his ruling: “Give the living baby to the first woman. Do not kill him; she is his mother.”

The following points were highlighted:

1. How is it that two prostitutes got an audience with the king? While getting an audience with an earthly king may not be an easy feat, anyone can go freely to King Jesus and He will listen. What a mighty God we serve!
2. When they went to the king, he sent his attendants to go get his sword. Hebrews 4:12 states the Word of God is active and alive. When you have conflicts and problems, go to the sword, the Word of God.
3. Be careful who you hang out with. Some people only know how to lay their burdens on others. Get radical. Do not claim the burdens of others.
4. Ask for wisdom. When King Solomon was appointed to this leadership position, somewhere between the ages of 18 to 22, he
5. understood that wisdom was essential for leadership. The church—and the world—desperately need godly wisdom.
6. Who will stand up for the life of a child? Elder Bryson challenged the congregation to speak up against abortions. An estimated 1,126,000 abortions occurred in the United States in 2025. There were 16.7 abortions per 1,000 women.

Call to Action:

Wisdom is essential.

Pomegranate

For this week's food medicine, we are looking at pomegranate. This fruit is rich in antioxidants, fiber, and a variety of vitamins and minerals. Its high level of antioxidants protects cells from damage and reduces inflammation. This fruit is indicated for those with infectious diarrhea caused by colitis. Surprising results have been achieved in chronic cases such as ulcerative colitis or Crohn's disease eating pomegranate. The citric acid in pomegranate has a beneficial effect on the intestines as it contributes to the restoration of the intestinal bacterial flora. The rind or inner part of the fruit is excellent for eliminating intestinal parasites, in particular tapeworm.

Studies have shown that pomegranates can protect the heart by lowering blood pressure and reducing blood sugar levels. This is because pomegranates contain potassium, magnesium, and polyphenol compounds called ellagitannins. These compounds help prevent the artery walls from thickening and it lowers the buildup of cholesterol and plaque. Atherosclerosis, which is the buildup of cholesterol and fats in the arteries, is a common cause of heart attack, stroke, aneurysm, and blood clot. The good news is that pomegranate helps to reduce low-density lipoprotein cholesterol, which is the bad cholesterol that clogs arteries, and increases high-density lipoprotein cholesterol which is the good cholesterol which lowers the risk of strokes and heart attacks. Pomegranate is also of value in cases of gout, excess uric acid, and obesity because of its alkalizing and purifying effect. This fruit is a wonderful remineralizer, alkalizer, and depurative food.

Did you know...?

The pomegranate is one of the oldest fruits known to humans; it's deeply embedded in our history. For thousands of years, it has been a vital provider of food and medicine across different cultures and civilizations.

Ancient cultures understood the health benefits of pomegranates and used it in remedies for digestive disorders, skin disorders, and intestinal parasites, to name a few.

Then God said, "I give you every seed-bearing plant on the face of the whole earth and every tree that has fruit with seed in it. They will be yours for food." - *Genesis 1:29*
