Lesson 1 (The Truth About God)

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Lesson 2 (The Truth About The Bible)

Note: The Bible was the first book ever printed; this occurred in AD 1450. The King James, or authorized version, was printed in A. D. 1611 and is the greatest example of classical English today. The Bible contains 66 books -39 books in the Old Testament, which begins with Genesis and ends with Malachi, and 27 books in the New Testament, beginning with Matthew and ending with Revelation.

There are 929 chapters in the Old Testament and 260 chapters in the New Testament. The number of verses in the Old Testament is 23,214, and 7959 in the New Testament. As for words, there are 592,493 in the Old Testament and 181,253 in the New Testament. The Bible is God's holy, inspired word. The Holy Ghost guided the thoughts of its writers (2 Peter 1:21). All Scripture (Old and New Testament) is inspired by God (2 Timothy 3:16).

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Lesson 3 (The Truth About Jesus' Birth)

Matthew's Gospel tells about the virgin birth of Jesus, the Savior of mankind, which is certainly one of the greatest mysteries of all time (Matthew 1:18-25). We also see him in his role as co-creator of this world in Genesis 1:26. When God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness," etc. He was speaking to his son Jesus, who existed before creation. (For additional understanding, read John 1:1-15, Colossians 1:11-17, Revelation 19:11-13 and John 17:1-5.)

Whether you address Him as the "Anointed One, the Messiah, Son of God, Son of Man, Emanuel, the Word, the Lamb of God, the Mediator, the Lord our Righteousness, Master, Lily-of-the-Valley, Rose of Sharon, Bright and Morning Star, King of kings, or Lord of lords," you are still referring to Jesus, which means Savior, who loved us so much that he gave his life on Calvary for you and me. (John 3:16).

One sure way to get him off your back in a hurry is to pray to God for strength to resist his temptations, and He will run! (James 4:7)

As much as we may think of prayer as an emergency telephone call, it isn't quite like that. There are conditions for answered prayer. There are three simple and important conditions that you must put into practice if you want answers to your prayers: (1) Pray "Your will be done." (2) Be forgiving to others and forgiven by God, (3) Accept God's 10 commandments as the standard for your life. The answer will come. Be ready to recognize it. It may be "Yes," "No," or "Wait." But whichever way it works out, remember this promise: "If we love God and are fitting into his plans." (Romans 8:28).

Some people pray often, others rarely, but as Shakespeare said, "At wit's end, all men Pray."

Jesus gave the following commission to his disciples just before leaving them for his home in heaven: "Go you, therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I've commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the world." (Matthew 28:19, 20)
