We enjoyed playing in the snow, sliding down the hills, and making snow ice cream. I'm glad everyone is safe.

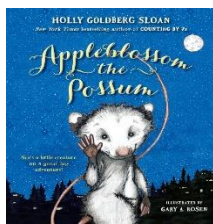
Please remember to fill out your child's paperwork that I sent home to bring back on Friday.

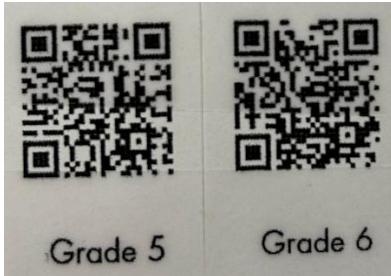
