IXL & Reading at Home: I love seeing that some students are already completing their IXL at home—great job! Let's work toward having everyone do their IXL practice and daily reading at home.



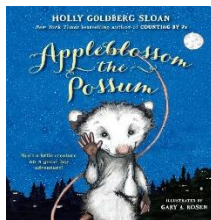

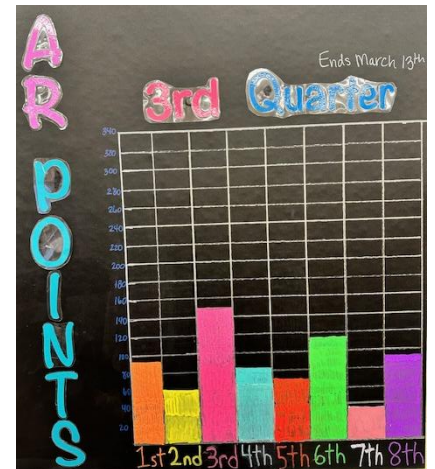
