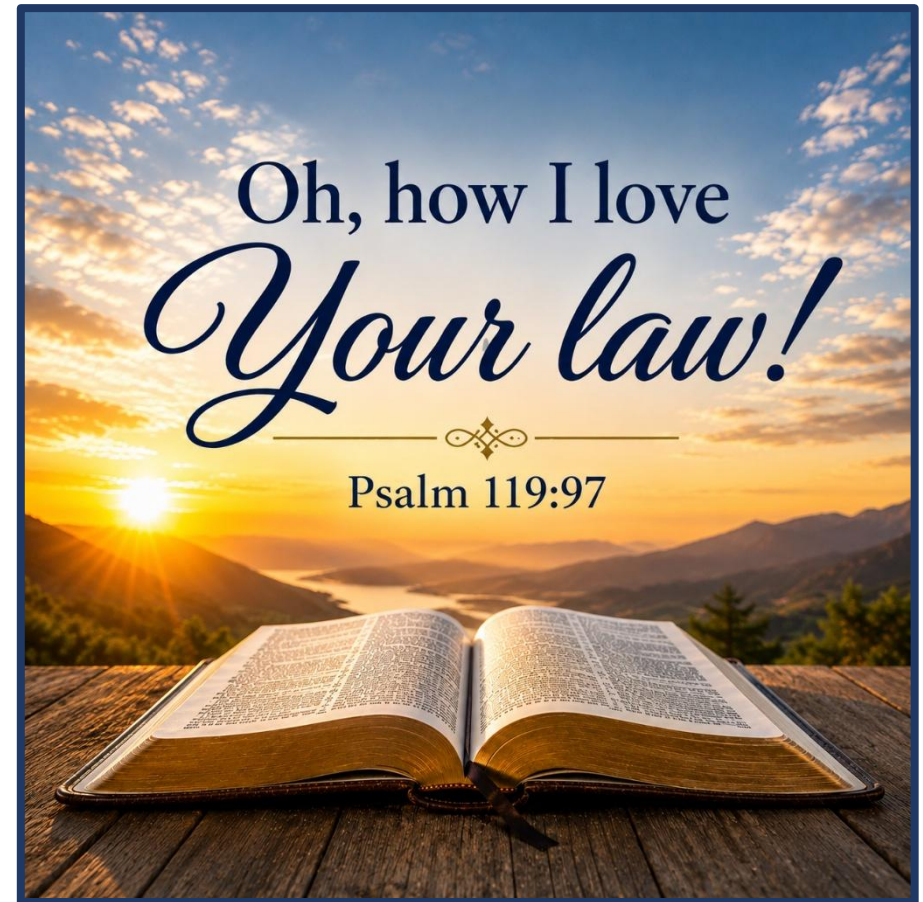
FOOD PANTRY: Hampton Roads is closing the vegetarian food store. Please see Peggy Halifax for any remaining food stock.

RELIGIOUS LIBERTY CORNER: A coalition of faith leaders and Texas parents have launched a constitutional challenge to Texas Senate Bill 10, which requires every public-school classroom to display the Ten Commandments in a prominent location using a King James Bible translation. The coalition has asked the U.S. Supreme Court to overturn the law.

The challenge follows a 9–8 decision by the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals upholding the law and declaring that the Supreme Court's 1980 decision in *Stone v. Graham*, which prohibited similar classroom displays, is no longer binding. The Fifth Circuit majority argued that the posters do not establish religion because they require neither prayer nor religious instruction.

Eight judges dissented, arguing that the lower court improperly disregarded Supreme Court precedent and underestimated the coercive effect of mandatory religious displays on students.

The families argue that the law imposes a particular religious interpretation on children and interferes with parents' authority over religious upbringing. The case could determine whether states may require biblical displays in public schools and potentially affect similar efforts underway in at least 24 states.
