7. **Jesus must be Michael as Jesus has all the characteristics of Michael. Michael is our prince; Jesus is the Prince of Peace. Michael stands watch over us; Jesus stands watch over us (makes intercession as He stands before/with the Father). Michael stands up (stops interceding) and the time of trouble begins and then the second coming takes place; Jesus comes, after finishing His work of intercession at the second coming to deliver the living righteous and resurrect the righteous dead. Michael and Jesus are the only ones in Scripture that are referenced with the term, "archangel." Michael resurrects Moses; Jesus is the resurrection and the life and will resurrect all of the righteous dead. Michael and the LORD are the only two in Scripture to ever use the phrase, "The LORD rebuke you" (both references are toward Satan). Jesus is referenced as having angels (being in charge of them); Michael is referenced as having "His angels." The term "Angel" is used many times to refer to beings other than "angels" including God Himself multiple times in Scripture (Genesis 16, Genesis 31:11-13, Exodus 3:2-4, Judges 6:11-14, etc...).**
