THE HONG KONG HEIST — A Modern Parable of Deception

In January 2024, a finance worker at a multinational firm in Hong Kong authorized \$25 million in wire transfers after a video call with his CFO and colleagues. Every single person on that call was fake—a deepfake generated by AI. He trusted his senses over his initial suspicions, and the money was gone. This is a parable of the final deception.



AMAZING FACT 1

The Perfect Counterfeit. The AI deepfake perfectly synchronized lip movements and matched the cadence of each speaker's voice. It was a technological counterfeit so convincing that a trained professional surrendered his judgment.



AMAZING FACT 2

A \$5 Million Industry. In 2025 alone, Americans reported \$5 million lost to AI voice-cloning scams. A machine can clone the voice of a loved one from just a three-second audio clip.



AMAZING FACT 3

The Two Great Errors. Through the immortality of the soul and Sunday sacredness, Satan brings people under his deceptions. The former lays the foundation of spiritualism; the latter creates a bond with Rome.



AMAZING FACT 4

Fire from Heaven. Satan performs great signs, even making fire come down from heaven. He plagiarizes the signature miracle of Elijah on Mount Carmel to convince the world.



AMAZING FACT 5 — THE CROWNING ACT

A Majestic Being. "In different parts of the earth, Satan will manifest himself among men as a majestic being of dazzling brightness, resembling the description of the Son of God given by John in the Revelation." — GC, p. 624



AMAZING FACT 6 — THE FATAL FLAW

The Manner of His Coming. "Satan is not permitted to counterfeit the manner of Christ's advent. The Saviour has warned His people against deception upon this point, and has clearly foretold the manner of His second coming." — GC, p. 625

"For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect."

Sermon Application: The deepfake heist is a powerful metaphor for the final deception. Satan will use supernatural signs, a majestic appearance, and even the words of Christ to deceive the world. He will claim to have changed the Sabbath to Sunday. The only way to survive is to be so grounded in the Word of God that you do not trust the evidence of your senses when it contradicts Scripture.

The finance worker knew something felt wrong, but he trusted his senses over his knowledge. When have you felt pressure to trust what you see or feel over what you know to be true from God's Word?

THE WARNING FROM THE MOUNT OF OLIVES

Deception is the First Concern

On the Mount of Olives, the disciples asked Jesus about the signs of His coming. His very first words were not about earthquakes or wars. He said, "Take heed that no one deceives you." The danger He identified is sophisticated impersonation—a deliberate counterfeit that borrows the language and miracles of the genuine.

The Greek words for false christs and false prophets describe those who intentionally assume the title and authority of the Messiah to deceive. They come wearing the garments of truth, performing signs and lying wonders powered by satanic energy.

Elijah and the Still Small Voice

In 1 Kings 19, Elijah is at the end of himself. He ran from Jezebel, sat under a juniper tree, and asked God to take his life. He said: "I alone am left." He felt completely isolated, cut off from every ally and every human voice that might tell him the mission was still on track. The signal had gone dark on his end. But God sent him to Mount Horeb, and there He spoke. Not in the wind, earthquake, or fire, but in a *qol demamah daqah* — a still small voice, the sound of a thin silence.

The communication blackout of Elijah's life was the moment God's voice came through most clearly. Elijah felt utterly alone, but God was actively preserving him. What he did not know was that there were seven thousand in Israel who had not bowed the knee to Baal. He had never been alone. The signal had gone dark on his end, but the mission had never paused on God's.

The Counterfeit of the Dead

Satan will also bring before us the appearance of our loved ones who have died. They will speak with the same voice and recall familiar memories. If we do not know the biblical truth that the dead sleep until the resurrection, our broken hearts will lead us into deception.

This is why the state of the dead is a crucial safeguard. Jesus called death a sleep. Whatever being wears a loved one's face, it is not them. Every Adventist doctrine—the Sabbath, the state of the dead, the sanctuary—is armor designed to protect us in this crisis.

Diligent Students of the Word

How will God's people survive? "Only those who have been diligent students of the Scriptures and who have received the love of the truth will be shielded." We must learn the voice of Jesus through daily, unhurried time in His Word so we instantly recognize the counterfeit.

The Manner of His Coming

Satan can counterfeit almost everything, but he cannot counterfeit the manner of Christ's advent. Jesus will return visibly, universally, and unmistakably. Every eye will see Him. He will descend with a shout, the voice of an archangel, and the trumpet of God. It is a cosmic event, not a local one.

The Remnant Stands

Revelation 14:12 describes the people who stand: "Here are those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus." They do not yield to the evidence of their senses when it contradicts the Word. They are anchored in the law and the testimony.

— Isaiah 8:20 (NKJV)

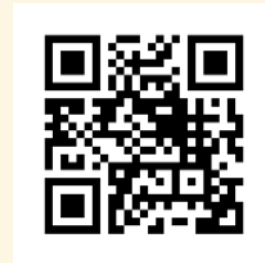
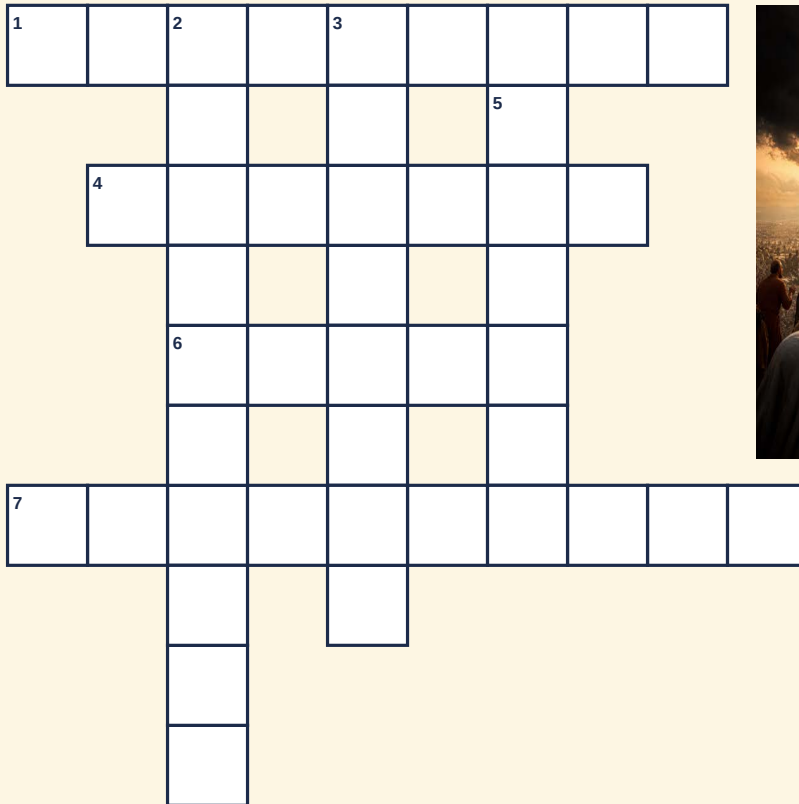
KEY THOUGHT
