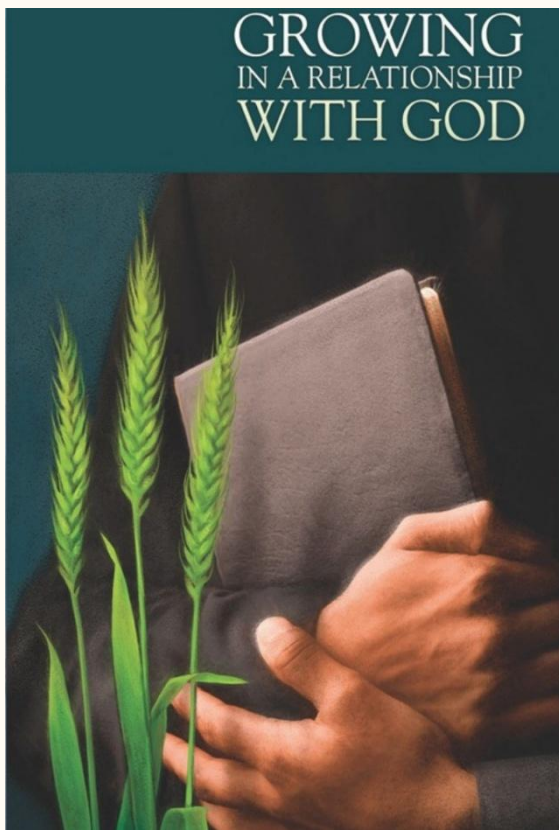

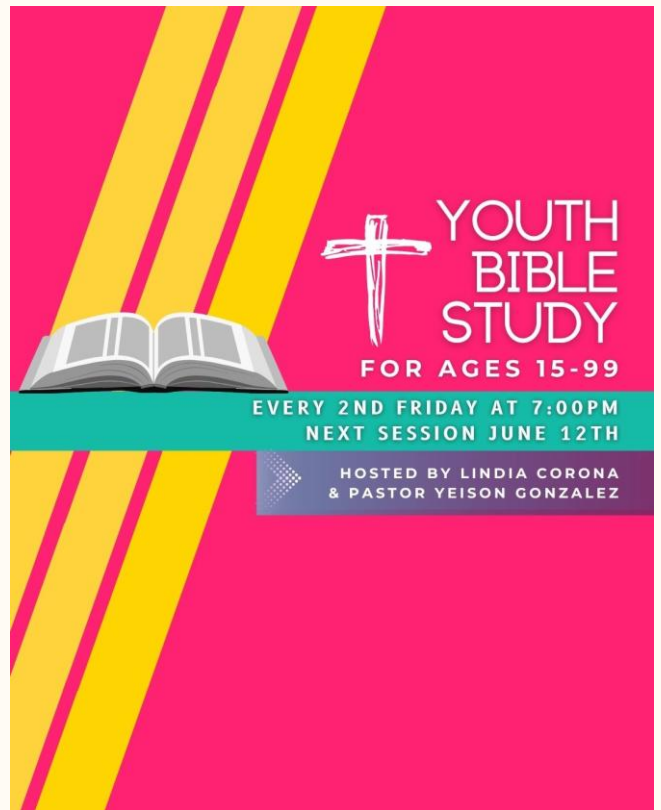

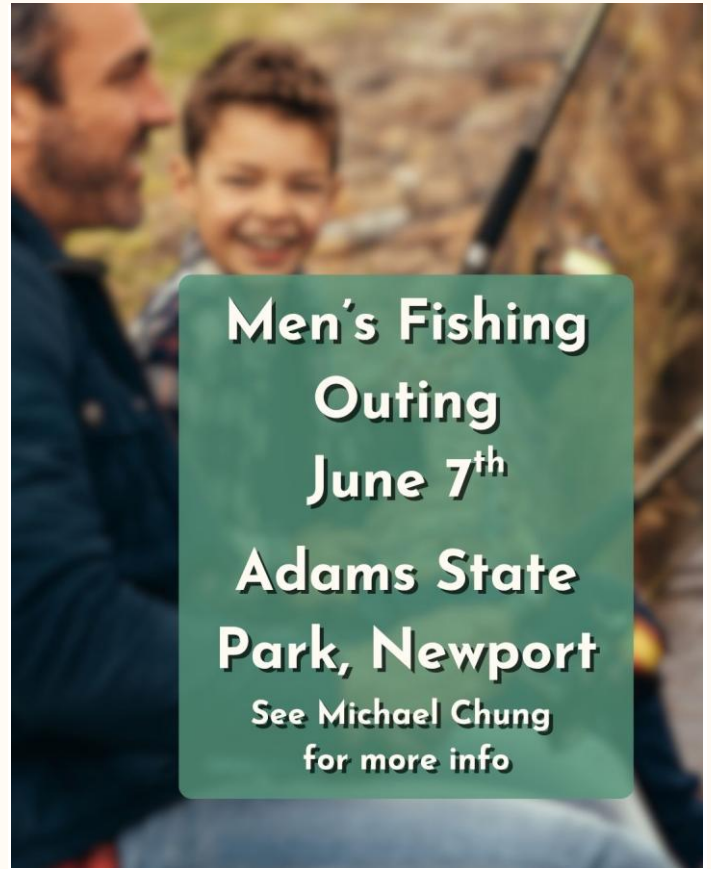

Mental Health Awareness Month

Health Ministry presents the 2nd Issue of Your Health Spotlight

“Carry each other’s burdens, and in this way, you will fulfill the law of Christ.” — Galatians 6:2

May is Mental Health Awareness Month — a time to recognize the importance of emotional, mental, and overall well-being. Many people experience stress, anxiety, depression, grief, loneliness, or other mental health challenges, often silently. Raising awareness helps reduce stigma and encourages people to seek support when needed.

Jesus cared for the whole person — mind, body, and spirit. The Bible reminds us that we are never alone in our struggles and that God is close to the brokenhearted (Psalm 34:18). Seeking help through prayer, trusted friends, pastoral support, counselors, or medical professionals is not a sign of weak faith; it is a step toward healing and restoration.

Each year, Mental Health America selects a theme to guide its May campaign. For 2026, the theme is **“More Good Days, Together”** — a message that reflects MHA’s core mission of helping people experience more good days by meeting them where they are, supporting them as whole people, and recognizing that “good” looks different for everyone. The theme encourages individuals and communities to consider what a good day means to them and to use those insights to shape advocacy, education, and mutual support. The **green ribbon** serves as the international symbol of mental health awareness, representing growth, renewal, and hope.

Ways We Can Support Mental Wellness

- Pray for one another regularly.
- Listen without judgment.
- Encourage rest, healthy habits, and time with God.
- Check in on those who may be isolated or discouraged.
- Be willing to seek professional help when needed.
- Remind others that their lives have value and purpose.
- Check in on family, friends, and neighbors.
- Listen with kindness and without judgment.
- Make time for rest, healthy habits, and meaningful connections.
- Reach out for help when feeling overwhelmed.
- Encourage others to seek professional support when needed.
- Show patience, compassion, and understanding.

The Bible recognizes that people experience fear, sadness, stress, loneliness, discouragement, and emotional struggles. Many biblical figures faced difficult mental and emotional challenges, yet found strength, support, and hope through God and their communities.

- Psalms contain many honest prayers expressing anxiety, grief, and emotional pain.
- Elijah experienced exhaustion and deep discouragement after a stressful period of ministry (1 Kings 19).
- David often wrote about fear, worry, and the search for peace in difficult times.
- Jesus Christ showed compassion to people who were hurting emotionally, physically, and spiritually.

The Bible encourages caring for the whole person — mind, body, and spirit. Scriptures such as Philippians 4:6-7, Psalm 34:18, and Galatians 6:2 remind us about peace, comfort, and supporting one another during difficult times.

Ways Churches Can Support Mental Wellness

- Create a safe and caring environment.
- Encourage open conversations without shame or judgment.
- Support prayer, encouragement, and healthy relationships.
- Promote rest, balance, and self-care.
- Encourage people to seek professional help when needed.

Mental health struggles do not define a person's worth. Everyone deserves compassion, support, and hope. You are loved. You are valued. You are not alone.
