OFFICIAL UNIFORM GUIDE

Grades 9-10

TOPS (Days Vary)

- **Monday, Wednesday, and Friday**
 - Yellow Polo shirts
- **Tuesday and Thursday (Physical Education)**
 - AAIS yellow P.E. shirt with logo

BOTTOMS

- **Girls**
 - Khaki knee-length skirts

**Females have the option of wearing Khaki uniform pants during the cooler season. (Thanksgiving break to Spring break)*

- **Boys**
 - Khaki pants

WINTER WEAR

- Solid Navy Blue (sweaters, sweatshirts, and light jackets)

SHOES

- Non-scuff, all black closed-in uniform shoes.
- Non-scuff sneakers of any kind may be worn during P.E and recess only.

P.E. UNIFORM

P.E. Classes are held on Tuesdays and Thursdays

- Yellow P.E. shirt with AAIS logo
- Navy blue shorts or sweatpants
- Navy blue sweatshirt - optional



FORMAL UNIFORM ATTIRE

If a student chooses to participate in performances or special days/events, the following attire is required.

- **Boys:**
 - Yellow Oxford Button-Down Shirt
 - AAIS Navy Blazer with Logo
 - AAIS Uniform Tie
 - Khaki Slacks
 - Dark Socks
 - Black Shoes
- **Girls:**
 - Yellow Button-Down Collar blouse
 - AAIS Navy Blazer with Logo
 - AAIS Uniform Tie
 - Khaki Skirt
 - Khaki Socks/ Stockings
 - Black Shoes

JEANS DAY

There will be some specified Fridays that will be considered Jeans Day. It is an opportunity for the students to wear a modest, approved, individualized look while participating in the school fundraiser. Participating students will be charged \$1.00. Please be advised that Jeans Day is a privilege, not a right.

Clothing items that are not permitted on Jeans' Day include:

Students may **NOT** wear ripped jeans, shorts, PE Clothes, sweat/jogging pants, stretch pants, mini-skirts, pajamas, camouflage clothing, leggings, tight-fitting pants, undershirts, tank tops, sleeveless tops, backless tops, low cut tops, midriff-baring clothing or other clothing designed as undergarments. Clothing must **not** contain any inappropriate language, art, or advertisements.

Footwear: Only sneakers or closed-in appropriate shoes are allowed.

**If a student decides not to participate in Jeans Day or does not have permission to do so, the regular Friday uniform attire is to be worn.*
