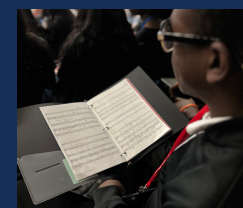
Community Service

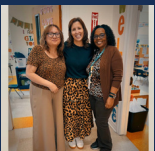
