



Greetings Preschool Families,

This week our class touched base on the Easter season beginning with Jesus riding into Jerusalem on a donkey and the people waving palm leaves, the last supper, and finally his death and resurrection. The kiddos painted a wooden cross and worked on a sticker sheet as well as created a lamb refrigerator magnet. We ended our week with an Easter feast and an Easter egg hunt where the students were tasked with finding the egg with their name on it and bringing it to me to collect a prize (a mini figurine of Jesus). Because it's almost impossible to get around the discussion of the Easter Bunny, we created our own origami bunny using a washcloth, ribbon, google eyes, and rubber bands and made a scratch off Easter Egg. Our assignments consisted of some Easter math (counting and identifying the correct number), patterns, and matching Easter items. We also discussed the letter "L" and practiced writing and identifying objects that begin with that letter. The preschoolers have earned a reward day of pajamas (no slippers) and pancakes on Monday, April 6th.

Our Spring Program will be on Tues., April 21 at 6:30 pm. This program is fun because the students are usually more comfortable than at the Christmas Program and personalities tend to come out even more, providing a pretty entertaining evening.
