Woodpecker

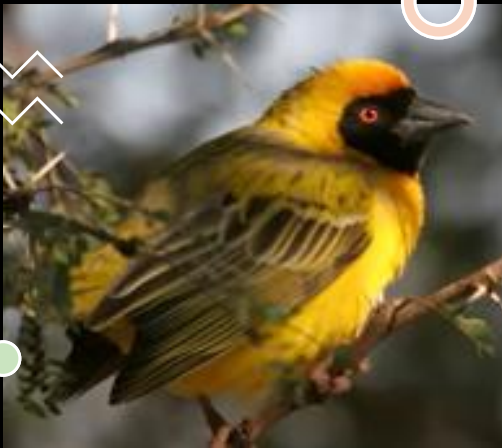

Nest: 8000 twigs, mud, cloth. Weighs up to 50 pounds.

Has a tunnel with a hidden nest inside.

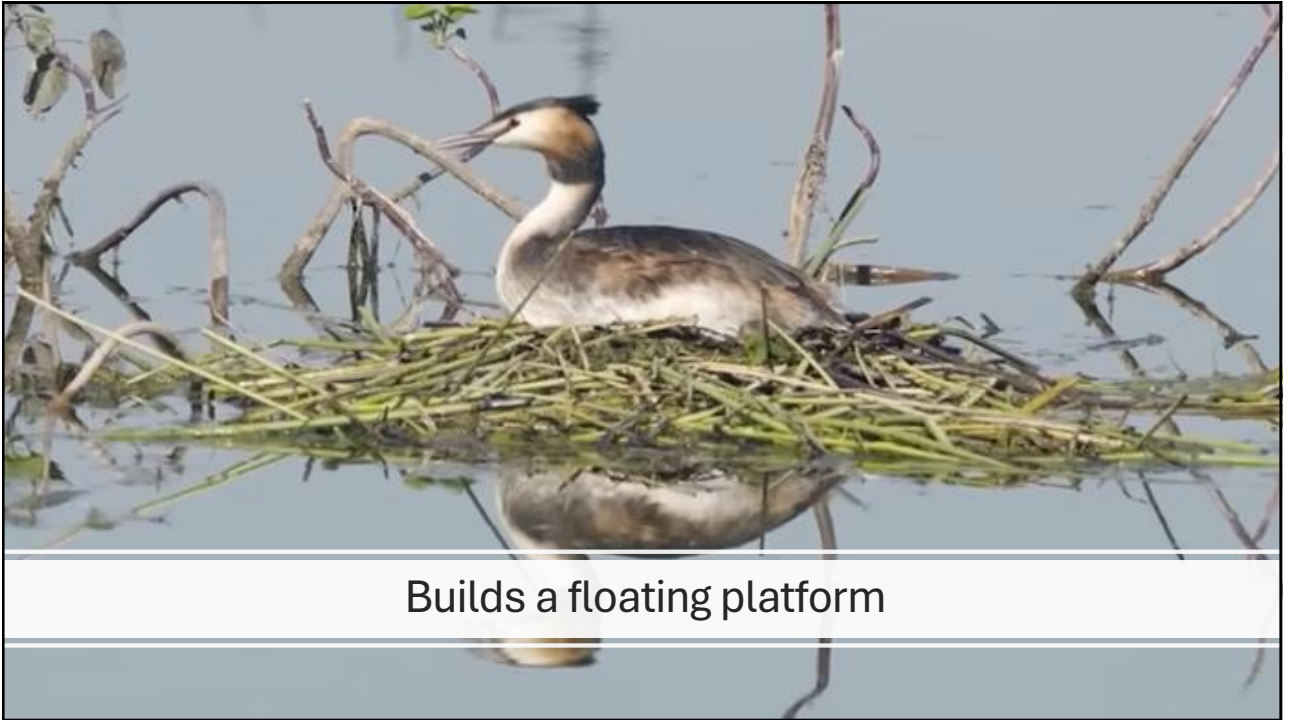
Barrow into cliffs sometimes 1 yard deep into the mud.
