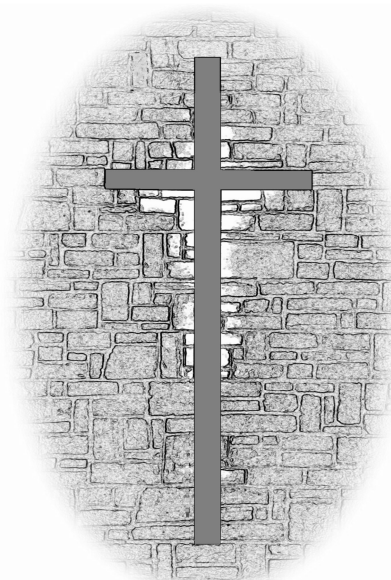

Representatives from the Ohio Conference of Seventh-day Adventists were pleased to share with the Church Board on Sunday, July 19, that after much prayer and discussion, they are sending one of their most commended pastors to the Miamisburg Seventh-day Adventist Church, beginning very soon in August, date to be announced.

Elder Bob Cundiff, President, and Elder Oswaldo Magaña, said Pastor Marton will be moving here from Elyria, where he currently pastors near Cleveland, with his wife, Marika, and two sons, Austin (to attend SVA), and Landen (attending Southern Adventist University).

Miamisburg SDA will be in a district with the Stillwater SDA Church in Vandalia, who also will be pastored by Pastor Marton.
