*John 13:4-17; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26.*

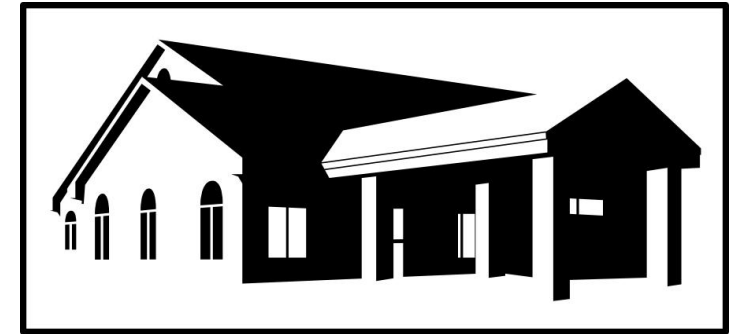
In the gifts of the Spirit, including the Spirit of prophecy.
