

# BCA SUMMER NEWSLETTER

As we prepare for the upcoming school year, we want to share important information regarding tuition billing and enrollment contracts.

## Tuition Billing

On **July 1, 2026**, all families will receive an invoice for the **first half of the school year (August-December 2026)**. A second invoice will be issued in December for the January-May semester.

## Self-Pay Families

Parents who are paying tuition without a scholarship will need to schedule an appointment to complete and sign their enrollment contract **in person**. Please contact the school office at **(334) 264-2101** to schedule your appointment.

## Scholarship Families

For families receiving scholarship funding (Choose Act, Education Scholarship, etc.), your enrollment contract will be included in your **Welcome Packet**, which will be mailed and distributed beginning **July 20, 2026**.

Please return contracts promptly to ensure your child's enrollment is finalized for the 2026-2027 school year.

As we prepare for the 2026-2027 school year, we want to remind all families to begin purchasing uniforms as soon as possible to ensure your scholar is ready for the first day of school.

Bethany Christian Academy has a limited supply of uniforms available on-site for purchase. Families may also purchase approved uniform items from other vendors such as Cookies, Walmart, French Toast, or similar retailers, provided the items meet BCA uniform requirements.

## Important Uniform Guidelines

### Girls' Uniforms

- **All skirts must be the official BCA-approved plaid skirt.**
- Solid blue skirts are **not permitted**.
- Plaid jumpers for eligible grades must also be BCA-approved.
- Boys' and Girls' Pants
- Khaki uniform pants may be purchased from BCA or other approved retailers such as Cookies, Walmart, or French Toast.
- Pants must be uniform-style khaki pants and meet school dress code standards.

### Grades 6-8 Uniform Requirements

## **Class A Uniform Days**

### **Monday, Wednesday, and Friday**

Students are required to wear:

- BCA Blue Blazer
- White Dress Shirt
- BCA Tie
- Khaki Pants (boys) or Approved BCA Plaid Skirt (girls)
- Black or Brown Dress Shoes

#### **Please Note:**

- Tennis shoes are **not allowed** on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- Shorts are **not allowed** on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.

## **PE Uniform Days**

### **Tuesday and Thursday**

Students may wear:

- BCA PE Uniform
- Athletic Shoes/Tennis Shoes
- Approved uniform shorts

**Shorts may only be worn on Tuesday and Thursday.**

## **Uniforms Available Through BCA**

The following items may be purchased through the school while supplies last:

- BCA Plaid Skirts
- BCA Ties
- BCA Blazers
- BCA Sweaters
- BCA Jackets
- Uniform Shirts
- School Patches (if needed)

## **Important Logo Notice**

Bethany Christian Academy has adopted a **new official school logo**.

Parents purchasing new uniform items, jackets, sweaters, backpacks, spirit wear, banners, or other customized school apparel should ensure that the **new BCA logo** is used on all newly purchased items.

The school has copies of the new logo available in the front office. If you are ordering items from an outside vendor, please stop by the office to obtain the correct logo before placing your order.

**Please do not purchase or create new items using the old BCA logo.**

Existing items with the old logo may continue to be used during the transition period; however, all newly ordered items should feature the new official logo.

## **Order Early**

We strongly encourage families to purchase uniforms as soon as possible to avoid backorders and shipping delays. Scholars are expected to be in full uniform beginning on the first day of school.

**Reminder:** Before ordering any embroidered or customized uniform items, please obtain the new official BCA logo from the school office. New items featuring the old logo will not be approved.
