Needed for Fellowship Dinner a volunteer to fill in when one of the regulars can't be there. Please contact Dana Chapin if you are able to help with this.

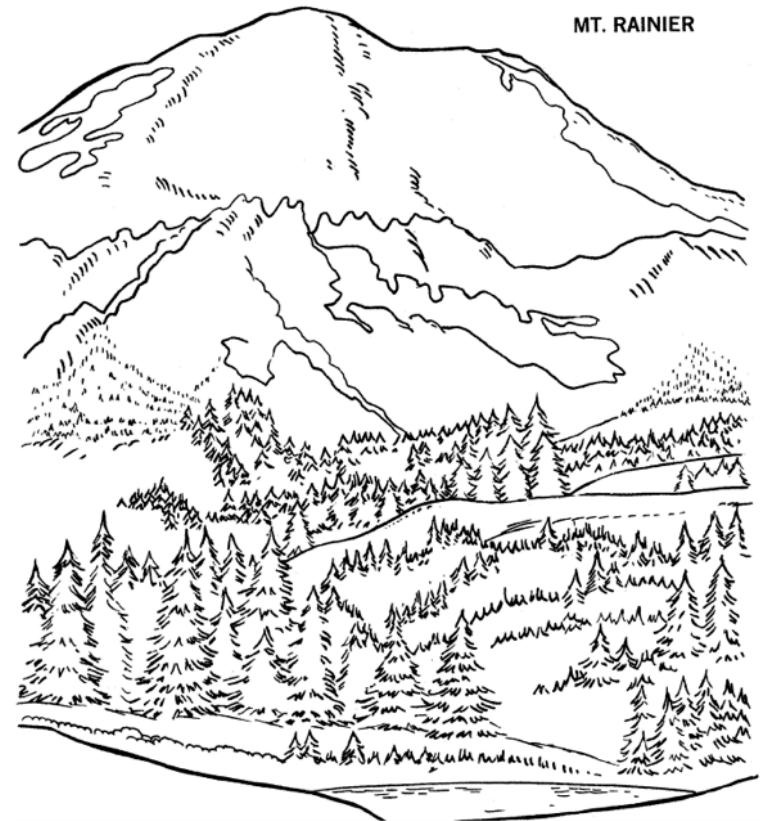
