Business Meeting Report: Thirty-six church members attended the business meeting on 29 January. Approved was a recommendation to **add the following as voting board members:** APCS Principal (Erin Miller), the Interest Coordinator from the Outreach Committee (Eunice Pearson), the Master Plan Committee chairperson (Glen Hughes), the Membership Clerk (Lynn Miles), and the Prayer Ministries Leader (Lori Blanco). Eunice and Glen were already board members representing different ministries. Copies of the business meeting minutes are available to members from the church office.

Church members at the business meeting on 29 January approved a **2026 church budget** which now includes loan payments for the APCS gym (29% of budget) and the partial funding of a staff position (still being defined and needing Conference approval) that will work with worship and youth, similar to what was voted by the church in 2023, but had been paused due to pastoral transition. This expense has been estimated to be at least \$27,000. These and other additions will increase potential church budget expenses to \$273,574. Copies of the voted church budget are available to members from the church office.

Sterling Volunteers: As followers of Christ in Seventh-day Adventist organizations in the North American Division, we believe it is our responsibility to nurture and protect the vulnerable within our communities, including our children and youth. As part of this effort, those over 18 who are voted to serve in volunteer roles within our church will be asked to complete a background check and child protection training through Sterling Volunteers. All voted volunteers will receive an email to begin this process. This should be completed every three years.
