



TUITION AND FEES 2026-2027

<u>Grade Level</u>	<u>Registration Fee</u>	<u>Tuition</u>
T/K – 6 th Grade	\$575	\$9,750
Grades 7 th – 8 th	\$575	\$10,950

Full registration payment is due in July 2026. Full tuition is due in August 2026, or as a convenience may be spread over 10 months, with the first installment due in August 2026 and the final installment due in May 2027.

Additional fees may also apply, such as sports/art/field trip fees, etc., as described on the attached Additional Fees Schedule.

Discounts

Family Discounts: Two (2) or more Students 5% on tuition for 2nd+ Child(ren)

\$50 Early Enrollment Discount: If you enroll on or before **March 31, 2026**, and pay at minimum \$150 when you submit your enrollment packet, you will receive a \$50 discount when the remainder of the registration fee is billed in July 2026 via FACTS Tuition Management. After 3/31/26, the full registration fee will be due at the time of enrollment, and the \$50 discount will **not** be available.

FACTS Tuition Management

All families must register with FACTS Tuition Management. FACTS registration information will be provided separately.

All missed payments will be assessed a \$25 late fee the month that a payment is not made in full by the due date. If an account exceeds 60 days, the parent(s) will be asked to meet with the School Business Office to discuss financial arrangements and/or withdrawal of their child until the account is brought current.

Any student with a debt from the prior school year will **NOT** be allowed to register for the following school year – until the debt is paid in full.

Withdrawal of Enrollment

A 30 calendar-day notice is required for early student withdrawal. If a student is withdrawn without giving 30 days' notice, a fee equal to one month's average tuition will be charged as a withdrawal fee.
